HOLY BULL IN PUBLIC WORKOUT Holy Bull (Great Above) had his final major workout for Sunday's \$500,000 Haskell Invitational between races at Monmouth Park yesterday. The three-year-old, who was on the muscle in the paddock, went seven furlongs in 1:24. "He was a little sharp in the paddock, but that's expected working him in the afternoon," said owner/trainer Jimmy Croll. With exercise rider Bobby Perna in the irons, Holy Bull reeled off fractions of :23 2/5, :46 3/5 and 1:11 1/5. "I thought he'd go in 1:24 and that's what he did," said Croll. "He was just going easily out there. He's very deceiving, especially for the rider. It doesn't look like he's going that fast, he goes so easy."

TWO ALTAZANO TO ALABAMA Two Altazano (Manzotti), handy winner of Saturday's GII Monmouth Oaks, came out of the race in good order and will now be pointed for the GI Alabama at Saratoga August 13. "She came out of the race alright. She got bounced around coming out of the gate; I think the horse next to her nicked her a little bit, but it was minor," said trainer Michael Stidham. "We're taking things race by race, but so far she's handling everything. We're looking at the Alabama next, unless she gives us a reason not to."

SAM HOUSTON OFFICIALS REACH AGREEMENT WITH TEXAS HBPA Officials at Sam Houston Race Park have reached an agreement with the Texas Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association which will allow the continuation of the current Quarter Horse meeting which runs through September 18. The agreement will allow five of the six major stakes to be run as scheduled without cutting purses for overnight races below the minimums set before the meet began. The horsemen have agreed to allow the track to expand its simulcasting of Thoroughbred racing.

Home Of The Free (Hero's Honor), a lightly raced six-year-old gelding, looks for his first win of '94. The Rokeby homebred won three of his five starts last year; he was third in the Gill Jaipur in his '94 bow, then finished fourth in the Gill Poker last time out. "In the Jaipur, he got dog-tired," said Hall of Fame trainer Mack. Miller. "It was his first start since November 2; I forgave him for that. The second time he was blocked in the stretch. He had a very good chance of winning, but he had to check. He had no place to go." With grass racing cancelled the first two days of the Saratoga meet due to heavy rains, there is a good chance of a soft course this afternoon, but Miller is not overly concerned. "He handles soft turf okay," he remarked. "He runs his heart out every time." Trainer Phil Johnson saddles **Kiri's Clown** (Foolish Pleasure), the winner of the Gill New Hampshire Sweepstakes H. in June and the Saratoga record holder for nine furlongs on the inner turf course; and **A In Sociology** (Ends Well), who captured the Gill Jaipur two starts back. The pair have combined for a three-for-three record at the Spa.

DE NIRO TO WAIT FOR BELMONT FALL

MEET De Niro (Gulch), who had originally been expected to make his next start in the GI Hopeful at the end of the Saratoga meet, will instead await the Futurity at Belmont Park September 17, according to trainer Allen Jerkens. "We can't run in everything," said Jerkens. "We'll let him catch up with himself. He has had three races and three good experiences; if we can run him three or four times in the fall, that will be good." The colt was 3rd as favorite in the Sanford on opening day at the Spa after breaking poorly. "He wasn't standing right, I could see it in the pictures," said Jerkens. "But he's been to the gate 1,000 times; I don't know what else we can do."
