UNITY CALLED FOR AT JOCKEY CLUB

ROUND TABLE Unity between owners and race-tracks was the theme for the 42nd annual Jockey Club Round Table, held Sunday in Saratoga Springs. The moderator for the event, Helen Alexander stressed the need for owners to take control, saying "We have abdicated our responsibilities as owners. It is time for us to step up and reassert ourselves; to take back some control of our destiny. If we don't, racing might not have a future that any of us can recognize." Echoing her sentiments, owner and Jockey Club member John Ed Anthony said, "For years we have complained that tracks have failed to promote our industry, that tracks have been slow to innovate and move in sophisticated ways to improve interest in our sport. I am convinced that the first critical step for racing is to coordinate efforts to pass the Thoroughbred Horse Industry Promotion and Research Act of 1994." The THIPRA is a \$25 million marketing program supported by the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association. Representing the racetracks, Thoroughbred Racing Associations Commissioner Brian McGrath stated, "To unite this industry is a daunting but essential task. This leads me to suggest that we do some serious thinking about what it is we can do regionally and locally to reintroduce ourselves to the public. These efforts may, in many cases, take place at the racetracks, but they are not the sole responsibility of the tracks. We must create a cohesion between the economic participants in this sport."

FOURSTARDAVE SUFFERS FRACTURE

Fourstardave (Compliance) suffered a hairline fracture of his left front cannon bone in Friday's GII Bernard Baruch H., in which he finished third. Trainer Leo O'Brien, who originally thought the nine-year-old gelding had merely twisted an ankle, said X-rays taken Sunday morning revealed the fracture. O'Brien also said Fourstardave will remain at Saratoga for at least one week past the end of the meeting, and will be rested in his stall for several months. The gelding's connections will decide next spring whether Fourstardave will race again, a possibility of which O'Brien is 75 percent certain. To date, the New York-bred has won 13 stakes, five of them graded, for earnings of over \$1.6 million.

The same order was maintained until well into the straight; Sayyedati took the lead two furlongs out and East of the Moon cruised up to challenge. With a furlong to run, Sayyedati still led, but East of the Moon proved too much, getting the better of her older rival in the drive to the wire. Mehthaaf stayed on well to be third. Both the winner and the runner-up have the Breeders' Cup Mile as their year-end targets, with East of the Moon trying to emulate her brilliant dam, dual Breeders' Cup Mile heroine Miesque. The three-year-old, winner of the GI Dubai Poule d'Essai des Pouliches and GI Prix de Diane (French Oaks) earlier this year, will be pointed for either the Prix du Moulin in France or the Queen Elizabeth II S. in England.

Via Borghese tried a new tactic, going straight to the front out of the gate, and it worked as she led through soft fractions of :24 3/5, :50 1/5 and 1:14 3/5, leaving herself plenty for the stretch drive. "I'm glad we decided to send her to the lead today," said winning jockey Jose Santos. "She was strong, and at the 3/8ths pole she had plenty left. The track is very deep today, and I figured that the horses who were 1-2-3 early had a good chance." Blazing Kadie, the longest shot on the board, made a run at the leader from third at the top of the stretch but was second best, while the lone three-year-old in the race, Coronation Cup, rallied from last to get the show. Alice Springs, winner of the GII Matchmaker at Atlantic City in her last, finished a disappointing 4th as the 7-5 favorite. "The slow fractions didn't bother her," said Alice Springs' trainer Jonathan Sheppard. "The competition was better than us today." Via Borghese, who now has three graded stakes victories to her credit, is 1/2 to Miswaki Tern (MGSP-N.A., GSW-Ity, by Miswaki). She will point next for the Flower Bowl (Sept. 24 at Belmont).

DEL MAR BREAKS SINGLE-DAY HANDLE RECORD Del Mar set a new track record for single-day handle Saturday. A total of \$14,779,935 was wagered on the Pacific Classic card, surpassing the old Del Mar mark of \$12,461,676, set on Pacific Classic Day last year.

PATTON RETURNS TUESDAY Promising three-year-old **Patton** (Lord at War), who finished just three-quarters behind Holy Bull in the GII Hutcheson S. in February, will make his return following knee surgery in Tuesday's fifth race at Monmouth, a \$20,000 allowance going six furlongs. Prepping for his comeback, the colt went a bullet five furlongs in :59. "We haven't put much pressure on him," said trainer Sonny Hine. "He's a very generous horse. He'll do whatever you ask of him. This horse has more raw ability than any horse I've ever trained." Patton will be pointed to the Jerome H. at Belmont in September. "Hopefully, this will set him up good," said Hine. "The big thing is that he finishes up strong."
