CO-TOPPERS AT TATTS WEDNESDAY

Hong Kong-bound juvenile **Craggy Cat (Ire)** (Statue of Liberty) made 280,000gns to share top billing at yesterday's penultimate session of the Tattersalls Autumn Horses In Training Sale in Newmarket. The two-time winner for trainer Luca Cumani will join John Moore in Hong Kong. JUST THEWAYYOUARE

Andre Fabre has missed out in the top-level juvenile contests run so far in France this term, but in **The wayyouare** (Kingmambo) he has the chance to resume normal business in today's G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud. Successful in the Sept. 21 Listed Criterium de Lyon and G3 Prix Thomas Bryon over this track and trip last time Oct. 13, Sean Mulryan's half-brother to the Ballydoyle phenomenon Peeping Fawn holds strong claims of providing his trainer with his second renewal following the exploits of Carlotamix (Fr) two years ago. "Mr. Fabre would not run him in a Group 1 if he didn't like him and he has been getting better with every run," the owner's Racing Manager Herve Barjot told *PA Sport*. "He is certainly bred to stay. The ground will be different to what he has tried before, but we have to run him to see how good he is." **Criterium International cont. p3**

ENGLISH CHANNEL TO STAND FOR \$25,000

English Channel (Smart Strike--Belva, by Theatrical {Ire}), retired to Hurricane Hall after his victory in last Saturday's GI Breeders' Cup Turf, will stand his initial season at stud for a fee of \$25,000, it was announced yesterday. "We plan to do some extraordinary things with English Channel from a bonus and incentive standpoint," said Hurricane Hall's Ben Walden Jr. "There will be an energetic commitment put forth toward the development of this horse. We hope to have English Channel arrive to the farm by the first of next week and for the sales." A six-time Grade I winner, English Channel will not be syndicated and will stand as property of Brad Kelley and Jim Scatuorchio. English Channel raced in Scatuorchio's colors while trained by Todd Pletcher.

JUVENILE DARK ANGEL RETIRED TO STUD

In a surprise move, this year's G1 Middle Park S. winner **Dark Angel (Ire)** (Acclamation {GB}--Midnight Angel {GB}, by Machiavellian) has been retired to stand at Morristown Lattin Stud in Ireland. Following the grey's ninth placing in Newmarket's G1 Dewhurst S. last month, the decision was made to send the juvenile to stud before his Classic season. Owned by Catherine Corbett and Christopher Wright and trained by Barry Hills, he was the winner of four of his nine starts and £341,306 in prizemoney. He took the £300,000 St Leger Yearling S. at York in August before defeating Strike the Deal in Newbury's G2 Mill Reef S. in September and Newmarket's Middle Park the following month. Corbett explained to the *Racing Post*, "The sale came through his trainer, Barry Hills, who was approached by the stud. He wouldn't have run in a Classic next year. It was felt he would be a six-furlong specialist and it's very hard for a three-year-old who has won a Group 1, so selling him wasn't really a wrench." No fee has been set for Dark Angel, who will stand alongside Definite Article (GB), Desert Style (Ire), Kris Kin and Camacho (GB) at the Naas operation in County Kildare.

Following the sophomore's errant display when running out in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Monmouth on Saturday, the decision was taken to send the dual Group 1 winner to the paddocks. In total, Simply Perfect collected in four of her 13 starts, including last year's G1 Fillies' Mile and G2 May Hill S. and the G1 Falmouth S. at Newmarket in July. She was also third in the G1 1000 Guineas in May.

Her trainer Jeremy Noseda paid tribute yesterday. "She has been a top-class filly at two and three, winning a Group 1 in both seasons," he commented. "She was a pleasure to train and has been great to have around the yard. She will head to Coolmore in the next week to 10 days and I hope she will go on to become a good broodmare. I was very disappointed with what happened at Monmouth Park and am still unsure as to why she took such an erratic course."

close to winning on fast ground. He has returned in good order and will now head to the December Sales after a season in which he has shown high-class form. The horse has been progressive and has a big future. He goes to the sales, although unless he makes what we feel is a reasonable figure in the ring, we would be very happy to bring him back home and campaign him on as a three-year-old."

DOZEN BIANCONE HORSES TO SAHADI A dozen horses trained by the recently suspended Patrick Biancone have been transferred to Jenine Sahadi's stable in California, reports *Daily Racing Form*. The group includes GSP **Trick's Pic** (Favorite Trick), who is slated to start in Sunday's GII Las Palmas H. at Santa Anita, as well as SP **Time Squared** (Fusaichi Pegasus) and the two-year-old filly **Strike Out** (Grand Slam), a first-out winner at Keeneland who goes next in the Nov. 11 Moccasin S. at Santa Anita. "It's a great opportunity," Sahadi told *DRF*. "I'm grateful, and I'll try to do my best with it. You just try to maintain continuity, keep them doing what they have been doing, and keep them happy." The horses, who reportedly double the size of Sahadi's stable, are owned by a variety of people.

IDIOT PROOF TO HONG KONG? GI Breeders' Cup Sprint runner-up **Idiot Proof** (Benchmark) will breeze on the turf and, if the three-year-old takes to the surface, could make his seasonal finale in the grassy \$1.5-million G1 Hong Kong Sprint at Sha Tin Dec. 9, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The Marty and Pam Wygod homebred has never raced on the grass. He shipped back to trainer Clifford Sise Jr.'s base at Santa Anita on Sunday morning from Monmouth and was glad to be back, said Sise. "He wasn't quite himself in the stall at Monmouth," he commented. "Plus he was coming back in 20 days, and he had a little bit of colic on the plane going over. I'm giving him a lot of credit [for finishing second]."

After landing Craggy Cat, Alastair Donald commented, "To me he was the best-looking two-year-old in the sale and has the scope to be a better three-year-old. He should be a serious miler in Hong Kong, he'd probably run a couple of times next year, but time will tell whether he stays a mile and a quarter of the Hong Kong Derby trip as a four-year-old. This is the first time that Moore has bought at this sale, but he has had Group 1 winners for the past three seasons from England in Viva Pataca (GB), Tiber (Ire) and Sunny Sing (Ire), so he decided to come here. He wants to buy in the U.K. rather than Australia now. I've got 10 for Hong Kong this week." The British Bloodstock Agency's Martin Percival outbid David Loder at 280,000gns for multiple stakes winner **Assertive (GB)** (Bold Edge {GB}). Percival was acting for Lady Whent, who was buying out her two partners in the colt. Agent Anthony Stroud was shopping for Dubai Carnival prospects, among them four-year-old **King of Argos (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), who he bought for 205,000gns. Trainer Walter Swinburn was the underbidder. "He's going to run in Dubai, but I don't know who will train him," said Stroud. "You really want horses rated 98 and above to run there as the races are quite hard to get into and there have been very few suitable horses this week." U.S.-bound purchases include two-year-old filly **Gypsy Baby (Ire)** (Modigliani), a winner for trainer Richard Hannon. She was bought for 135,000gns by Gordian Troeller to join Californian trainer Bob Hess. Owners Paul and Cathy Schroder will campaign the filly. The sale's final session begins today at 9:30 a.m.

STATE OFFICIALS LIFT QUARANTINE ORDER FOR HALF OF CHURCHILL BARN The Kentucky Department of Agriculture has lifted a quarantine order for half of Barn 47 at Churchill Downs. The barn was placed under quarantine last Friday after a horse was found to be infected with equine herpes virus (EHV-1). Sixteen horses trained by Al Stall, Jr. were allowed to return to regular training Tuesday at Churchill after Kentucky Department of Agriculture determined that none were suffering from an active EHV-1 infection and there was a "minimal" opportunity for exposure to the virus. The 40-stall barn is divided by a firewall and the infected horse was stabled on the other side of the structure. But 19 horses trained by David Carroll--a total that includes one stable pony-- remained under quarantine on Tuesday and confined to their side of Barn 47. A three-year-old trained by Carroll was the lone horse to test positive last week for EHV-1. That horse was moved to a Lexington, Kentucky equine hospital after he displayed unusual symptoms on Thursday and later was discovered to be infected with EHV-1. All 19 horses on Carroll's side of Barn 47 have returned negative results on nasal and blood tests designed to detect infection by the virus. Rusty Ford, equine programs manager for the office of Kentucky State Veterinarian Dr. Robert Stout, DVM, said those horses would be tested again early next week and their status would continue to be evaluated by the State Veterinarian's office. All horses that enter and depart Churchill's stable area are required to present a veterinary certificate of health stating the horse has been healthy for the previous 72 hours. Horses that ship in to compete in Churchill Downs races are required to stable in either the receiving or stakes barns, and those barns--along with the starting gate, paddock and equipment used by outriders--are being regularly disinfected.

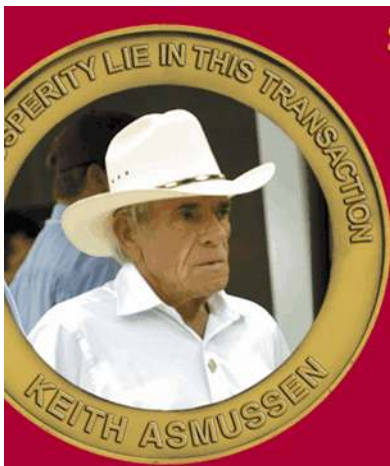
