# GALILEO RECOVERING FROM COLIC SURGERY

Galileo (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), the leading sire in Europe, underwent surgery Thursday after he was found to be suffering from a bout of colic at Coolmore Stud in

Ireland. The 10-year-old son of Urban Sea was referred to Fethard Equine Hospital for evaluation, where he underwent the procedure, "Galileo had colic surgery yesterday evening," Coolmore General Manager Christy Grassick confirmed. "We are delighted with his progress overnight and his

recovery has been uneventful. He is doing very well and we expect him to be returning back to Coolmore very shortly." Winner of the G1 Epsom and Irish Derbies and the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. in 2001, Galileo entered stud the following season and has been a smashing success, siring no fewer than 15 Group 1/Grade I winners, including Epsom Derby hero New Approach (Ire); Lush Lashes (GB), a treble winner at the highest level this season; and GI Breeders' Cup Turf winner Red Rocks (Ire), who most recently outran Curlin by two lengths in the GI Man O' War S. in New York. From four crops to race, Galileo is the sire of 35 overall stakes winners with progeny earnings in excess of \$22 million.

# **UNDER HER SPELL**

MGISW Proud Spell (Proud Citizen) is the class of the field in today's GII Fitz Dixon Cotillion S. at Philadelphia Park. Under the wire first in seven of her 11 career starts, the Brereton Jones homebred cruised by five lengths in the May 2 GI Kentucky Oaks. She had to settle for second behind Music Note (A.P. Indy) in the June 28 GI Mother Goose S., but followed up with a victory in the July 12 GII Delaware Oaks. Proud Spell turned the tables on Music Note in her latest. Narrowly in front as they turned for home in the Aug. 16 GI Alabama S. at the Spa, she looked certain to be overtaken by the Godolphin runner inside the eighth pole, but pinned her ears and turned back the challenge to win it by a head. If the bay filly doesn't bounce off that effort, she will be tough to beat today, but trainer Larry Jones does have one concern. His charge will give from five to 10 pounds to her rivals. "She's only a little bitty filly," Jones told Daily Racing Form. "Giving away 10 pounds to almost every horse in the field is a lot for her." Cotillion field, p6



### HOME PRODUCTION

Foxwood Plantation's homebred Star Production (Run Production) carries the local hopes for today's GII Super Derby at Louisiana Downs. The son of Louisiana stakes winner Zarb's Star (Zarbyev), the dark bay gelding was second in three straight before galloping to an eightlength score over state-bred stakes foes Aug. 2. The 6-5 chalk in the Prelude S. two weeks later, he held on gamely to win it by a nose. He is likely to find himself on the lead again today. "Our horse likes the front end," trainer James Hodges told Daily Racing Form. "He started running 100 Beyers when we put him on the front end, so that's the way we kind of look at it." # OFF THE HOOK IS ON THE MARK

It has been a long but productive sale for Off The Hook, the collaboration of Venezuelan trainer Carlos

Morales and entrepreneur Joe Appelbaum. In addition to advising one of their top clients, Jose Castro's Paula C Racing Stable, on the purchase of Sunday's session-topping Macho Uno colt, Off The Hook has signed the ticket on 15 yearlings at Keeneland September. They took home two of the three toppers in Lexington vesterday,

going to \$160,000 for hip 3731, a Holy Bull colt, and to \$170,000 for hip 3984, a Forest Danger colt. Both were consigned by Gracefield. "We're buying for our pinhooking partnership and for private racing clients like Mr. Castro," Applebaum said from Lexington yesterday. "We break the horses for the individuals who race, we get them ready for the track and we help in selecting trainers." The New Yorker admitted that the Keeneland September grind is taking its toll. "It's been long and tiring," he said, but added, "We didn't really participate at [Fasig-Tipton] July and we bought very modestly at OBS August, so we are a little bit making up for lost time. And we've seen a lot of horses we like." But what you see is not always what you get. "We have found it very difficult to buy," Applebaum said. "It seems that all the buyers coalesce around the same horses, especially later in the sale. The horses the last couple of days have brought more than we expected. You've had to step up and go after the ones you wanted. If there is a good horse over \$100,000, everybody is on it." The middle market is where Off The Hook tends to buy, although their KEESEP purchases include a couple from the lower end of the spectrum, such as a \$20,000 Yankee Gentleman colt and a \$47,000 Five Star Day colt that was bought for Paula C Racing. "We are in transition," Applebaum explained. "We used to buy all over the lot, but now we generally like to stay between \$100,000 and \$200,000. We feel the residual value is greater and, if they do well, we can hopefully make some money." There are just four days left at Keeneland September, but the Off The Hook partners are about ready to go home. "We've just about used up all our money," Applebaum quipped. The 15 lots signed for by Off The Hook (Paula C Racing was listed as the buyer of the \$400,000 Macho Uno) have totalled \$1,694,000, averaging \$112,933.

# **Buck Pond Scores With Session Topper...**

Douglas S. Arnold's Buck Pond Farm consigned the top seller at Keeneland yesterday. Going through the



ring as hip 3803, the colt, by Bernstein out of Sparkler (Carson City), was bought by Gulf Coast

Farm for \$190,000. "I loved the colt," Arnold said. "Lance Robinson and Jerry Bailey [of Gulf Coast] are two of the best pinhookers in the business. They are very shrewd buyers and I really think they got a hell of a deal. This colt was back here in Book 6; the mare's first foal was in Book 2, and she brought \$290,000. Since then, a half-brother to the mare won a graded stake and set a new track record. Why they put us in Book 6, I don't know. He brought a lot of money for today, but I really thought he was a \$300,000 kind of colt." The bay is out of a half-sister to graded winners Softly (Binalong) and Coragil Cat (Forest Wildcat), who captured the May 24 GIII Hanshin Cup and the May 3 Timeless Native S., setting a new Arlington mark of 1:33 3/5 going a mile in that test. Arnold purchased Sparkler for \$65,000 at Keeneland January in 2005, and bred her to Johannesburg. The resulting foal, a filly named Innovative, broke her maiden in her second start, winning on the turf at Colonial Downs in August. Asked what caught his eye about the dam, Arnold said, "She's by Carson City, and I liked that." He also found the influence of champion two-year-old Crimson Satan in the pedigree to be a draw, and has paired the mare with Storm Cat-line stallions, adding a Crimson Satan cross to the mix. Sparkler has a weanling colt by Forest Wildcat, and is back in foal to Johannesburg. Buck Pond was established by Doug and wife Karen in 1994, and sits on 300 acres near Versailles. They currently stand 10 stallions, including Lost Soldier, sire of champion Lost in the Fog, and promising freshman Seattle Fitz (Arg).

Second in the Aug. 1 GII Honorable Miss S. at the Spa, she enters this off a win in the restricted Bennington S. 19 days later.



The huge efforts take their toll, and it's been three years since he's been able to put two top tries back-to-back. In fact, he's only been able to run his best one time in each of the last two years, and both times only when he was fresh and returning from layoffs. He did the same thing this year and although he did come back to that figure, it took him almost seven months to do it. It's extremely unlikely Commentator can now pair up that effort at age seven--which doesn't necessarily mean he'll lose here since he's a lot faster than most of these--but it makes him vulnerable.

# 3 Won Awesome Dude Awesome Again Lambert 8-1 Didn't race until he was four, and got a whole lot better this year at age five. In June he improved yet again, running a negative figure despite losing to Solar Flare in an allowance. Not surprisingly, he backed up for a couple of races, but not badly, and now he comes into this with good rest. He's the second fastest horse going in, and there's every reason to expect him to fire

4 Cuba Not For Love Cotto Jr 6-1
Was strong and sound at age four before falling
apart, and it took him three years to get back to that
level. He ran his best two back and almost as well last
time only 13 days later--which might be a problem.
Multiple big efforts with little rest can have a cumula-

tive effect, even with good rest afterwards. It's hard to

tell what this guy will do.

5 Volcanic Force Quaker Ridge Dooley

Is better than ever at age six, and ran the best race of his life two back. But even that effort won't do it here, and he probably won't run his best again this soon.

6 Dr. Pleasure Thunder Gulch Velasquez 7-2

Is another with soundness problems, as we can see from his history of short campaigns interspersed with layoffs. As we saw with Commentator, unsound horses often run their best off layoffs, and Dr. Pleasure did exactly that last time out, blowing away an allowance field at Saratoga. But he would have to run faster than he ever has to have any real shot here, and there is every reason to believe he ran his race last time, and won't improve now.

7 Riversrunrylee Outflanker Gonzalez 15-1
Has come a long way in a relatively short time from humble beginnings, and has run a top in every dirt route this year. He has a good chance to pair up or even go

forward, but this is a tough spot.

<u>Bottom Line</u>: Dr. Pleasure will be overbet here, making the race bettable. Won Awesome Dude gets serious weight from Commentator, and can beat that one if he doesn't run his best. He's our play, but we'll also play an exacta under Commentator out of respect.





That operation also paid €100,000 for Razza del Sole's hip 95, a Zamindar half-brother to this year's Listed Premio Vittorio Crespi winner Piperita (GB) (Observatory), who they bought from the same draft here 12 months ago. Bobby O'Ryan was on hand to buy Allevamento Mandorli's hip 28, a son of Invincible Spirit (Ire) whose dam is a half to the sire Marouble (Ire) and the 1998 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas and G1 Irish Oaks runner-up Kitza (Ire), later the dam of Fort Dignity. After the agent had paid €120,000 for the blueblood, he revealed that he will be trained by Dermot Weld. Alongside Stroud and O'Ryan, other overseas patrons of the Settimo Milanese complex included Coolmore's John O'Byrne, Jamie Railton, Con Marnane, Swiss trainer Miroslav Weiss and Shadwell's Angus Gold, who paid €80,000 on his sole purchase of SARL's hip 60, a daughter of their homebred stallion Navef whose page includes the top-class Ace (Ire), Danish (Ire) and Hawkeye (Ire).
