It has been a while since Luca Cumani enjoyed Classic glory, but in Stuart Stuckey's homebred Volume, he has a live contender who was successful in the May 16 Listed Swettenham Stud Fillies' Trial S. at Newbury prior to her Oaks run, where she was nosed out of second. "We're very happy with her, she has worked well and her preparation has gone according to plan," Cumani told *PA Sport*. "Obviously she was just behind Tarfasha at Epsom, so we're hopeful of a good run." Marvellous has to bounce back from a below-par effort in the Oaks, having won the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas here on testing ground May 27, where Palace was back in fifth. The latter's confidence may have been buoyed by a win in the Listed Cairn Rouge S. over an extended mile at Killarney Monday. "We dipped our toes in the water at a mile and a half in the Ribblesdale at Royal Ascot and she ran a blinder to be beaten only half a length by Bracelet. Whether we can reverse the placings on her home patch remains to be seen, but I don't see why we should be three times the price." Much intrigue is added by the fact that Joseph O'Brien is on **O "TDN Rising Star" O Tapestry (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who has been below the best of her juvenile form last of 17 in the May 4 G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket and sixth in the June 20 G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot. She looked smart at two when winning the G2 Debutante S. and finishing a promoted second in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. here last summer and is worth another chance.

and following a ninth-place finish in the G1 QIPCO 1000 Guineas May 4, heads to these shores following a respectable fifth behind Rizeena (Ire) (Iffraaj {GB}) in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 20. Rizeena, of course, returned to finish second in the G1 Qipco Falmouth S. at Newmarket July 11. Campaigned overseas by trainer Richard Fahey, the Al Shaqab Racing colorbearer will be saddled by former Todd Pletcher assistant Michael McCarthy here. "While it will be difficult returning in four weeks while shipping from overseas to California, Al Shaqab is commited to racing around the world," Al Shaqab's USA Racing Advisor Bradley Weisbord commented. "We thought that she would be a good fit for America as she really prefers firm ground. While a cut below Group 1 company in Europe, we have high expectations for her in the U.S." My Conquestadory (Artie Schiller) has drawn widest of all in post 12. Tabbed as a O "TDN Rising Star" O after beginning her career with a tour-de-force victory over the boys in the GII Summer S. at Woodbine Sept. 14, she stayed perfect with another visually impressive performance in Keeneland's GI Darley Alcibiades S. Oct. 4. She overcame a disadvantegous draw from post 14 to finish a solid fourth after leading in the stretch in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf Nov. 1. GI Diana S. - #9 Stephanie's Kitten (6-1)

What a competitive race to kick things off. You could probably make a case for every runner in this field, and there definitely appears to be some value to be had. I really liked Somali Lemonade last time going into the GI Just a Game S., and while I thought she ran valiantly to be third, pace-presser Discreet Marg is back to provide pressure once again. Add in the usually quick Emollient and an extra furlong, and it would seem that you definitely want a horse from off the pace. I normally pick against Stephanie's Kitten because she's frequently a short price, but after two disappointing efforts this season for Chad Brown, she figures to finally fly under the radar. There's reason to believe she just doesn't like the Keeneland turf course, as she's been off the board twice now as the favorite there, so we can draw a line through her reasonably close eighth-place run in the GI Jenny Wiley S. in April off the trainer change from Wayne Catalano to Brown. Last time in the Just a Game she was simply way too far back, but the Ramsey homebred came flying home for fifth. She covered her final furlong in a field's-fastest :11.11. If she can stay a little closer early here, there's no reason Stephanie's Kitten can't return to her best and mow them all down late. Bet: \$50 Win on #9 Stephanie's Kitten.

A game winner in her seasonal debut at Monmouth after sitting closer to the lead than she prefers, last term's GI E.P. Taylor S. victress was a very good second to the in-form Riposte (GB) in the 1 1/4-mile GII New York S. last out at Belmont June 28. With plenty of pace signed on in this turnback to nine furlongs, Tannery should be locked and loaded for her best third start off the layoff. **Bet: \$50 Win on #10 Tannery**.

Wise Dan Works at Saratoga...

Two-time Horse of the Year **Wise Dan** (Wiseman's Ferry) posted his second timed work since undergoing colic surgery May 16, breezing four furlongs in :49.12

over Saratoga's Oklahoma turf course Friday morning. With regular exercise rider Damien Rock aboard, the 7-yearold galloped out five furlongs in 1:02 1/5. Last year's GI Breeders' Cup Mile hero has been perfect in two starts this term, including the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic S. on the GI Kentucky Derby

undercard most recently. "That's a good sign," trainer Charlie LoPresti commented. "I couldn't be happier with that work. When we got him going to the turf this morning, just walking down the road, Rock said you could feel him start lengthening his stride. He knew he was going to work today. He jogged onto the turf course. He was so happy to go on there." LoPresti continued, "As far as colic surgery goes, it was a best-case scenario. It was almost like exploratory surgery." "So, the only thing we were dealing with was an incision to heal. He's such a strong horse, in 3 1/2 weeks, I can tell you, if you saw the video footage of him four days later when he came home, he jumped off the trailer at my house. In 2 1/2 weeks, he was dragging me around out in the paddock when I was grazing him. He's just an amazing horse." Wise Dan is under consideration for either the GII Fourstardave H. Aug. 9, the GII Bernard Baruch Aug. 30 or the GI Woodward S. on dirt Aug. 30.

Encryption Added to Haskell...

Stoneway Farm's Encryption (Exchange Rate), second in the GIII Pegasus S. June 15 and third in the Long Branch S. July 5, has been confirmed for the GI William Hill Haskell Invitational at Monmouth July 27. "We're throwing him into the deep end," trainer Kelly Breen said. "He's going to run in the Haskell. As of right now all systems are go. The horse is doing tremendous. I think we have a solid field of horses for the Haskell, but we're going to go after them." A field of nine, including the heroine of the GI Kentucky Oaks and GI Mother Goose S. Untapable (Tapit), is shaping up for the Haskell. "There's going to be plenty of speed in the race," Breen added. "I'd like to say that we can learn something from the Long Branch. Encryption has rated in the morning. It should be a pretty hot pace, between Bayern (Offlee Wild), Untapable, and Wildcat Red (D'wildcat)."

DETTORI MAKES SARATOGA SPLASH

With two wins and a second in three mounts Friday, jockey Frankie Dettori stole the show in his first visit to Saratoga Race Course.

Despite a late arrival that forced him to miss his first two assignments, Dettori made a smashing debut during opening day of the 146th season of racing in Saratoga Springs, N.Y. Wearing borrowed gear because his luggage didn't arrive with him on the flight from England, Dettori finished second by a half-length in the seventh race aboard Tiz Sardonic Joe (Tiznow), then guided Aventure Love (Fr) (Orpen) to a one-length victory in the eighth race.

"It's a childhood dream to ride a winner at Saratoga and I managed to do it," Dettori, 43, said. "It's a great feeling."

Two races later, Dettori's aggressive handling in the stretch lifted Jet Majesty to a three-quarter length victory in the finale.

Dettori rode Undrafted (Purim) to a fourth-place finish in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 12 for American trainer Wesley Ward and told Ward that he wanted to compete at Saratoga. When Ward said he would be happy to give the European star mounts on his horses at the Spa, Dettori took him up on the offer and made plans to spend the opening weekend. He is named on seven horses Saturday, including Stephanie's Kitten for trainer Chad Brown in the GI Diana S., two on Sunday and four more on Monday.

Saratoga was the third track in a different country in as many days for the globe-trotting Dettori. He was in Istanbul Wednesday night, rode in England at Doncaster on Thursday night, stayed overnight at the airport and caught a morning flight to New York. That flight didn't arrive at JFK until late morning, which forced Ward to replace him on horses in the first two races. After clearing customs and realizing that his luggage had not traveled with him, Dettori took a private flight to Albany International Airport, which is about 25 miles from the track.

For his day's work, Dettori wore a pair of Rajiv Maragh's pants, Joe Rocco Jr.'s boots and Julien Leparoux's whip.

"I've borrowed a bit from everybody," he said. "Hopefully my tack will arrive tomorrow."

Dettori waved to the crowd and delivered a pair of his flying dismounts in the winner's circle after Aventure Love's front-running victory in the 5 1/2furlong turf race.

"It feels great," he said. "I have a few rides this weekend, but to get the first one out of the way is great. It was a great feeling when I crossed that line. I felt like a kid again."

Though he didn't have much time to look around the track, Dettori said the opening day crowd of 25,612 made an impression.

"When I arrived, I thought I was in Disney World; so many people," he said. "I thought maybe I got the wrong venue. It's actually a racetrack. It's nice to see people at the races. The people make the atmosphere. You can build a beautiful place, but if you haven't got the warmth of the people it's nothing. You have a lot of warmth here."
