

## MARKET HOLDS STEADY AT F-T OPENER

SARATOGA SPRINGS, NY--The Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale of Selected Yearlings kicked off Monday evening with figures that were in line with at last year's renewal.

A total of 73 horses sold for a gross of \$21,215,000, compared to 2015 which saw 70 head sell for \$21,745,000 during its opening session. Average was down 6.45% from \$310,643 last year to \$290,616 this year while median was up 6.67% from \$225,000 to \$240,000. The RNA rate stood at 29.8% this year with 31 horses being led out of the ring unsold as opposed to last year's buy-back rate of 17.6% when 15 yearlings failed to meet their reserves.

"I thought overall tonight we saw a similar marketplace to what we saw last year and what we saw throughout the 2-year-old sales in 2016 thus far," said Fasig-Tipton President and CEO Boyd Browning. "The average is down slightly, the median is up slightly and the RNA rate is up from what it was last year. It's probably not unexpected. It was remarkably low the first night last year, so it is not out of line this year, but it is always a little higher than we would have liked."

## SONGBIRD HALF SELLS TWICE AS NICE

[Hip 61](#), a Ghostzapper half-sister to undefeated champion Songbird (Medaglia d'Oro), brought twice the price her Eclipse-winning sibling did at this auction two years ago when selling to PTK LLC's Tom Haughey for \$800,000 midway through Monday's opening session.

"She was great looking and well-bred and she is a half to Songbird," Haughey said outside of the walking ring after signing the ticket alongside his daughter Kaitlin and trainer Dane Kobiskie, when asked about the filly's appeal. "I expected to pay more. I think I got a steal."

"She'll go to the farm in South Carolina for a few months," Kobiskie chimed in. "We will let her take her time and let her grow up up and she will come in late next year [to Florida]."

Consigned by Hill 'n' Dale on behalf of breeder John Antonelli, the dark bay is out of GII Bonnie Miss S. winner Ivanavinalot (West Acre), who made \$647,300 on the racetrack. **Cont. p5**

## Market Holds Steady at F-T Opener

A colt by Pioneerof the Nile colt (Hip 111), who is a half-brother to GSW Ocean Knight (Curlin), topped the session when selling for \$950,000 to a powerhouse partnership between Stonestreet Stables and Coolmore.

“You wish you had a million-dollar horse,” Browning remarked. “We will see what happens tomorrow night. Hopefully there will be a few of those. There is restraint at the top of the market.

You see the trend of some of the major buyers partnering up, which would naturally tend to result in a little less competition at the very, very top and might provide a little restraint in those bid.”

Three horses reached seven figures during last year’s sale, but no horse hit the million-dollar mark during Monday’s session.

“I think we are seeing a market that has slightly

increased selectivity,” Browning commented. “People are watching what they spend and they have limits. They might bid

a time or two beyond what they were going to go, but they don’t bid with great enthusiasm or without restraint. The buyers thought it was pretty difficult to buy what they want and the sellers thought it was not easy selling tonight. It’s a pretty fair marketplace. It’s no walk in the park or picnic for buyers or sellers, but it’s a reasonable marketplace.”

The Saratoga Sale continues Tuesday evening at 6:30 p.m. in the Humphrey S. Finney Pavillion.



## A New Pioneer for Stonestreet, Coolmore

Stonestreet Stable's John Moynihan, standing alongside Coolmore's M.V. Magnier, signed the ticket at a session-topping \$950,000 to acquire a colt by Pioneerof the Nile ([Hip 111](#)) late in Monday's first session of the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga sale.

Stonestreet campaigns the yearling's half-brother Ocean Knight (Curlin), who won last year's GIII Sam F. Davis S.

"He is a pretty horse by a great stallion and we own his brother," Moynihan ticked off the yearling's appeal. "We thought a lot of his mother, we still do. He was one of our favorite horses here, so we took a shot."

Of the final price tag, Moynihan added, "It was a little high, but the good ones bring a lot of money."

The Coolmore/Stonestreet partnership was recently represented by first-out Saratoga winner Fact Finding (The Factor), who won for Todd Pletcher Aug. 6.

The yearling, consigned by Gainesway, was bred by Pavla and Erik Nygaard's Thor-Bred Stables, which purchased his dam Ocean Goddess (Stormy Atlantic) for \$270,000 at the 2007 OBS March sale. The mare's first foal, Ocean Knight was purchased by Stonestreet for \$320,000 at that same auction in 2012.

Monday's result was the biggest sale so far Thor-Bred Stables and Pavla Nygaard admitted the experience was one to remember for many reasons.

"I think it will take me some time to process the whole thing, but it was absolutely amazing," she said. "It was a culmination of a lot of things which are not easy in this industry. The mare was at first accepted for Pioneerof the Nile, but then we were told no and I had to fight to get her in there. And then, when the mare was in foal, at some point, the vet said it doesn't look like the foal is going to make it. So there were a lot of things that we did to help her and I was going through a lot of doubts, but when the foal was born, the vet said, 'This is the healthiest foal on the farm.'"

The couple originally thought to take advantage of American Pharoah's rise to prominence by selling the colt as a weanling last year.

"At the time, I thought he was a beautiful colt, but he just didn't look ready," Nygaard recalled. "I thought he would be that much better as a yearling."

Nygaard also gave credit to Gainesway's Brian Graves for getting the colt ready for his star turn Monday in Saratoga.

"Brian stepped up to the plate and said, 'How about [Gainesway] buys a piece of him and then we take him to the yearling sales together.' So that's what we did. Brian and the team at Gainesway did a tremendous job getting him ready."

Ocean Goddess produced a colt by Medaglia d'Oro this year and was bred back to Curlin.

The yearling is bred similarly to American Pharoah (Pioneer of the Nile), whose dam's sire is a son of Storm Cat. Justin Zayat, whose family campaigned last year's Triple Crown hero, was among the underbidders on Monday's session topper.

"We are pleased," said a smiling Antonelli, who maintains a

band of six broodmares at his farm in Santa Ynez, California. "Every horse owner wants seven figures for their horse, but that is about where we had her plugged in to be between \$700,000 and \$900,000. We are very pleased overall. I think she is going to be a runner. She

shows that as a yearling in just the little bit of training we do with her to get her prepared for the sale. She shows she can move and I think she can be a very talented filly. Everything remains to be seen though."

PTK, which stands for Paula, Tom and Kaitlin, currently has 164 horses in training with Kobiskie, who is a former jockey. They were also active earlier in the sale, going to \$275,000 to acquire [Hip 9](#), a Speightstown filly out of GSW Dreaming of Liz (El Prado {Ire}).

through the system and we’ll see where he ends up.”

China Horse Club, which also purchased [hip 46](#), a son of Uncle Mo for \$650,000 Monday night, currently has about 30 juveniles in training in the U.S.

“We’ve got some lovely horses and are looking forward to the racing season,” Wallace said.

“We followed a system last year, it’s a system we believe in. So we aren’t

going to change it this year. We’re confident in that system. It

seems to be working at this stage.”

The Tapit yearling was bred by SF Bloodstock, which purchased Fashion Cat, a half-sister to Grade I winner Peace Rules (Jules), with this colt in utero for \$400,000 at the 2014 Keeneland November sale. He was purchased by Top Line’s pinhooking partnership for \$390,000 at that sale in 2015.

“He was really popular, but with the market trends, \$750,000 was well sold,” commented Top Line’s Torie Gladwell of the yearling’s final price tag. “We are extremely happy. He was in our pinhooking partnership, so it was us and six other clients.”

Asked about the youngster’s appeal as a weanling, Gladwell said, “Obviously he’s by Tapit and he was half to a stallion already. He had a good presence to him as a weanling--a big walk--he was really immature then, but we thought he’d get there and he did.” [@JessMartiniTDN](#)

## PEDIGREE INSIGHTS: SIGNS OF BLESSING

Wonderful though it is to have a stallion of Galileo's extraordinary achievements, his near-total dominance has prevented several other worthy stallions from adding those magic words "champion sire" to their CVs. Galileo currently seems assured of recording his eighth Anglo-Irish championship in the last nine years, the only blip coming in 2009, when Danehill Dancer earned a well-deserved title. Among the other stallions which have had to play second fiddle to this virtuoso are such gifted individuals as Dansili, Montjeu (twice), Dubawi (twice) and Invincible Spirit, while Galileo's half-brother Sea The Stars is his nearest challenger this year.

Invincible Spirit did particularly well to finish runner-up to Galileo in 2014, as his progeny rarely stay well enough to shine in the 10- and 12-furlong events which often carry the most prize-money. However, he is perfectly capable of siring first-rate milers and in 2014 he was represented by two of them, with Kingman's sequence of Group 1 victories earning him Horse of the Year honours, while Charm Spirit won the very valuable G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. after two other Group 1 triumphs in France.

I thought Invincible Spirit was well placed to enjoy another stand-out year in 2016--especially at sprint distances--as he had been responsible for two of 2015's fastest juvenile colts. Shalaa ranked second on the European 2-Year-Old Racehorse rankings following a campaign which featured wins in four six-furlong group contests. Then there was Ajaya, conqueror of Ribchester in the G2 Gimcrack S. **Cont. p2**

## CHAUTAUQUA PREPARING FOR SPRING

Australian champion sprinter **Chautauqua (Aus)** (Encosta de Lago {Aus}) has returned to the Rosehill stables of Team Hawkes and is preparing for a spring campaign where he will race exclusively in Melbourne, according to *Racing.com*. The 6-year-old, who defended his G1 TJ Smith S. title at The Championships at Royal Randwick Apr. 2 before traveling to Hong Kong to take the G1 Chairman's Sprint Prize a month later, is set to take in the G1 Moir S. Sept. 30, followed by the G1 Manikato S. Oct. 21 and the G1 Darley Classic Nov. 5. He will then return to Hong Kong for the G1 Longines Hong Kong Sprint in December.

"He has spent the past couple of weeks in pre-training and is now back at Rosehill," co-trainer Michael Hawkes told *Racing.com*. "We will just give him a few days to settle in and then look to step his work up."

Unfortunately, Shalaa has been on the sidelines this year and Ajaya has failed to shine in two starts. Even so, Invincible Spirit has still made a major impact on Europe's top sprints, thanks to his older progeny. The 4-year-old Profitable, who

is destined to join the Darley stallion team, has scaled the group-race ladder, stepping up from the G3 Palace House S. to the G2 Temple S. and then to the G1 King's Stand S. And now a second Group 1 winner--his 13th in the Northern Hemisphere--has emerged in the shape of the French-trained Signs of Blessing, who took Sunday's G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest. There have also been listed sprint successes for Spirit Raiser, the durable Spirit Quartz and Rivellino.

Signs of Blessing's Deauville win means that Invincible Spirit has now sired the winners of four editions of the Maurice de Gheest, with the first three coming by

courtesy of that top-class sprinter-miler Moonlight Cloud. The 19-year-old's collection of top European sprints also features two editions of the G1 July Cup (via Fleeting Spirit and Mayson), a G2 King George S. (Muthmir) and two G2 Prix du Gros-Chene (Spirit Quartz and Muthmir). He has also gone close to winning Europe's three Group 1 five-furlong races--the King's Stand, the Nunthorpe S. and the Prix de l'Abbaye.

His other accomplishments include the title of leading first-crop sire in 2006 and two second places on the sires of two year olds table (on one occasion beaten by Galileo). His

effectiveness in this role has brought him three victories in the G2 Flying Childers S., two each in the G1 Cheveley Park S., G2 Gimcrack S., G2 Lowther S., G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte and G3 Molecomb S., plus single victories in the G1 Prix Morny, G1 Middle Park S., G2 July S. and G2 Richmond S. All these wins were gained over sprint distances, but he also showed a degree of versatility by siring Vale of York, who defeated Lookin At Lucky to land the GI Breeders' Cup

Juvenile over 1 1/16 miles on all-weather.

Although Invincible Spirit did all his winning over six furlongs, he very occasionally comes up with colts which stay a mile and a quarter or more, the prime example being his G1 Prix du Jockey-Club winner Lawman. Others include Allied Powers (G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly), Speaking of Which (G3 Gallinule S.), Grendisar (G3 Winter Derby), Born To Sea (second in the G1 Irish Derby) and the smart Ekkihaam.

It wouldn't have been a great surprise had Signs of Blessing developed into one of Invincible Spirit's better stayers, as his first four dams were sired by Seeking the Gold, Nashwan, Nijinsky and Round Table, all of whom won over at least a mile and a quarter. This, coupled with the fact that

Invincible Spirit's dam Rafha won the G1 Prix de Diane, should surely have allowed Signs of Blessing to stay at least a mile but his trainer Francois Rohaut has evidently never entertained any thoughts that the free-running Signs of Blessing was anything

but a sprinter. Only one of his 19 starts--his first--has been over a distance as long as seven furlongs and his speed has brought him eight wins.

Bearing in mind that there is a ready market for Invincible Spirit's stallion sons, the connections of Signs of Blessing must now be wondering whether they

made the right decision when they had him gelded in September last year. I'm sure they did. The facts are that the then-4-year-old had failed to shine in his four starts of 2015. And, although he had previously won a couple of listed races and the G3 Goldene-Peitsche, that wasn't a strong enough basis for a stallion career. The gelding operation has certainly paid off, helping Signs of Blessing reach new levels as a 5-year-old. His

Maurice de Gheest win was his third in five 2016 starts and follows a fine third in the G1 Diamond Jubilee, in which he led until the final 50 yards.

Had Signs of Blessing still been an entire when he won the Maurice de Gheest, he would certainly have attracted plenty of attention as a potential stallion. He could hardly have a better female line as his fourth dam, La Dame du Lac, was a daughter of the celebrated Cosmah. Not only did Cosmah produce Halo, but she was also a half-sister to Natalma, dam of Northern Dancer and third dam of Danehill, and to Bubbling Beauty, dam of Arctic Tern. Needless to say, Halo, Northern Dancer, Danehill and Arctic Tern all developed into champion stallions.

The links between La Dame du Lac and Signs of Blessing are Nazoo, winner of all four of her juvenile starts in 1990; Sunray Superstar, a listed-placed sister to Nadia, winner of the G1 Prix

Desert--Oasis Dream, Invincible Spirit and Cape Cross. She also has a yearling sister to Signs of Blessing which is scheduled to sell as [lot 129](#) at Arqana next Monday and she was covered this year by Oasis Dream's champion son Muhaarar.

One incentive for following this route is the marked success that Green Desert's sons have enjoyed with mares by a variety of Mr Prospector stallions. Cape Cross, of course, sired the superb Sea The Stars from a Miswaki mare, while Oasis Dream sired that top-notch racemare Midday from a Kingmambo mare, plus two Group 1 winners, Naaqoos and the top five-furlong horse Goldream, from Machiavellian mares. Invincible Spirit, for his part, owed his classic-winning son Lawman to a daughter of Gulch and his Group 1 winners Hooray and Territories to mares by Machiavellian.



Profitable looks likely to line up for the G1 Nunthorpe S. over five furlongs, the trip over which he won the G1 King's Stand S. at the Royal meeting.

"Profitable is in excellent form and I have been very pleased with him," said Cox. "The Nunthorpe is looking like a race to savour and we are very much looking forward to it."

Profitable finished fourth in the G1 Darley July Cup over six furlongs July 9.

"We decided after Ascot that we would like to give him a run between then and the Nunthorpe," Cox said.

### AL SHAQAB: VIRUS PROMPTED MOVE

Officials with Al Shaqab have moved to quash rumours about why its three horses with Criquette Head-Maarek were removed from the trainer's yard.

Head-Maarek suggested in an interview with *Paris Turf* over the weekend that her gender may have been the reason, but Khalifa Al Attiya, General Manager of Al Shaqab, said on Monday, "Al Shaqab had never intended for this to be the end of our professional relationship with Criquette Head-Maarek. The decision was taken to move a filly away from her yard due to the virus concerns. As a result we were told that we should move the three of them together, which we did."

Head-Maarek, who trained Treve (Fr) (Motivator {GB}) to wins in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in 2013 and 2014 for Al Shaqab, said she had not been offered an explanation for the move.

"I've no idea why they moved them, of course it was a surprise," she said. "You can't do much better than giving an owner two Arc wins. I've not spoken to anyone; they just called me a month ago and said they are going. It's not going to change my life." **Cont. p6**

## FIRST TRIAL FOR BLACK CAVIAR SISTER

**Brigite (Aus)** (Casino Prince {Aus}), the newly turned 3-year-old half-sister to undefeated world champion sprinter Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}) and full-sister to four-time Group 1 winner and young sire All Too Hard (Aus), had her first barrier trial at Cranbourne on Monday, finishing seventh of 12 in an 800-metre heat for trainer Ciaran Maher. Brigite was ridden by Luke Nolen, who partnered Black Caviar in 22 of her 25 starts for trainer Peter Moody.

Nolen did not push Brigite over the heavy track, and Maher told *Racing and Sports*, "Luke said she would appreciate a better

surface but she'll come on a lot from that. It's a starting point for her. She's a big strong horse that will need a couple of good hit-outs. She's still a little way off but we'll find a race when we think she's ready."

Brigite, who was retained by breeder Rick Jamieson, is the seventh foal out of the unraced Helsingie (Aus) (Desert Sun {GB}). Her lone winner since All Too Hard has been Belle Couture (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}), who raced four times and last year produced a Pierro (Aus) colt.

She was followed by a Redoute's Choice (Aus) colt who sold for A\$5-million at Inglis Easter but was later euthanised after suffering an adverse reaction to antibiotics administered for a spider bite. Helsingie's 4-year-old full-sister to Black Caviar, Naturale (Aus), is unraced as yet, and the mare has a yearling filly by Canford Cliffs (Ire). She is barren for 2016 after being covered last year by Not A Single Doubt (Aus).

Maher also sent his 2015 and 2014 G1 Crown Oaks winners **Jameka (Aus)** (Myboycharlie {Ire}) and **Set Square (Aus)** (Reset {Aus}) out in the first trial of the day and they finished first and fourth, respectively. Jameka is set to resume in Saturday's G2 PB Lawrence S.


