DESTINATION: KENTUCKY DERBY A

total of nine three-year-olds came out of Saturday's Kentucky Derby preps with tickets to Churchill Downs, and two more are on standby. Wood Memorial winner Unbridled's Song (Unbridled) came back from his easy victory in fine fettle and will fly to Kentucky Thursday. Also heading south from New York is In Contention (Devil's Bag), the Wood runner-up. Said trainer Walter Reese, "The race took something out of him, but it had to. He never carried that much weight, never ran that far, and he was running against the best he's ever run against. Up to this point, I'm happy with how he's come out of the race." Owner Robert Perez is looking for a spot in the gate on Derby Day for his Secreto de Estado (General Assembly), fourth in the Wood. "I think he ran a good race," said Perez. "It was his first time around two turns and he was short. One more jump and we get third." At Keeneland, trainer Sonny Hine said yesterday that Blue Grass winner Skip Away (Skip Trial) was "excellent" after his first-ever stakes win. Trainer Nick Zito, who saddled both Louis Quatorze (Sovereign Dancer), second, and Diligence (Miswaki), fifth, said the former is a Derby definite and that he hopes owner George Steinbrenner will also opt for the Derby with the latter. "Hopefully, we'll be able to roll the dice (with Diligence)," said Zito. "If we come up with an off track Derby Day, we'll try to fit him with (shoes) that will help him grab it." Editor's Note (Forty Niner), third as the Blue Grass favorite, will head the Team Lukas assault on Churchill as trainer D. Wayne Lukas bids for his sixth straight Triple Crown race victory. While trainer Shug McGaughey will detour off the Triple Crown trail with Blue Grass fourth Draw (Private Account), at least until the Belmont Stakes, trainer Bob Baffert is still considering a Derby try for Semoran (Phone Trick), sixth in the Blue Grass. "I'm going to work him in nine or 10 days and then decide," said Baffert. "That wasn't him (Saturday). He was just dull." The first three finishers from the GII Arkansas Derby complete the list of Saturday's Kentucky Derby prospects. Winner Zarb's Magic (Zarbyev) shipped back to Louisiana Downs Sunday; runner-up Grindstone (Unbridled) headed to Team Lukas' Kentucky camp yesterday; third-placed Halo Sunshine (Halo) also shipped to Kentucky Sunday. "Except for Unbridled's Song, the results (Saturday) left the Derby picture somewhat muddled," said his trainer, Richard Cross. "It is going to be an interesting three weeks as everything gets sorted out."

Undefeated in three previous starts at this distance, the West Virginia-bred pressed the early pacesetters before taking the lead a quartermile from home and outfinishing Western Winter in the final strides. "He just did everything perfect," said winning jockey Kent Desormeaux. "He was handy all the way; pulled me around there until it was time to go. It took some effort to get by the horse (Western Winter) on the rail--he can run. It took some effort to get by him, but we were inching away late."

OVERBURY TRIUMPHANT IN HONG KONG


Overbury (Ire) (Caerleon) overcame trouble to register an otherwise comfortable success in yesterday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin racecourse in Hong Kong. The five-year-old had traffic problems early in the straight but, given a fine ride by British champion jockey Frankie Dettori, eventually eased clear to win the \$330,000 first prize by 3 3/4 lengths from New Zealand-trained Sapio (NZ) (Vice Regal {NZ}), with Privilege (Ire) (Last Tycoon {Ire}) third. The race was marred when Hong Kong's Horse of the Year, local hero Makarpura Star (NZ) (Native Kingdom {Aus}), broke a leg and was put down. Overbury, successful in the GII American Derby for Newmarket-based David Loder in 1994, is now a member of the Godolphin string, who took this race last season with Red Bishop (Silver Hawk); he was eligible to run in the restricted Sha Tin event because Dubai, where he wintered, is a member of the Asian Racing Conference.

OAKLAWN MEET ENDS ON A HIGH NOTE

Attendance and handle for the 1996 Oaklawn Park meeting were down but the Arkansas track ended on a positive note, setting a record for total handle on Saturday's closing-day card. The season's largest crowd, 58,263, wagered \$4,394,989 on-track, which combined with a record off-track handle of \$6,258,529 to produce the new mark of \$10,653,518, topping the old standard of \$8,421,888 established a week ago on the Oaklawn H. program. Oaklawn's total attendance was 787,776; the daily average of 13,267 was down 6.8 percent from 1995 and marked the track's lowest average in 25 years. On-track handle for the season was \$94,138,159 for a daily average of \$1,595,562, off 4 percent from last year. Off-track wagering, however, reached \$161,969,345, an increase of 50 percent over the 1995 figure; boosted by the out-of-state betting, the total daily handle for the meet averaged \$4,340,805, a jump of 28.7 percent. Robby Albarado bested defending champ Calvin Borel in the jockey standings with 78 winners to Borel's 69. Trainer Bobby Barnett earned his third consecutive title at Oaklawn with 29 victories.

SERENA'S SONG HEADS TO CHURCHILL

Serena's Song (Rahy), third as the favorite in the Gl Apple Blossom H. Friday, flew from Arkansas to Kentucky yesterday and could make her next start in the \$200,000a Louisville Breeders' Cup May 3 at Churchill Downs. "She came out of the race real good," said trainer Jeff Lukas. "She never really got into it (in the Apple Blossom), never really got comfortable in that rain and sloppy going."



The Guineas is a different matter--all being well, he will run whatever ground conditions are then--but Newbury is definitely our first taraet."

Hern, meanwhile, is still waiting to confirm a definite decision over where Alhaarth will make his eagerlyanticipated first appearance of 1996. He underlined yesterday that he would much prefer to reintroduce last season's top-rated European juvenile at Newbury, but his continuing concerns about the weather are currently preventing him from committing himself.
