



GOFFS NOVEMBER BOWS OUT IN STYLE

Consecutive lots from Jim Bolger's Glebe House Stables fetched \in 90,000 and \in 85,000 to lead a much more relaxed day of mares' trade at Goffs as the six-day November Sale concluded in Kildare.

So much of the talk ahead of the auction had centered on the Paulyn Dispersal, but even without the near €13million contribution to the turnover from Paul Makin's horses, the 2013 breeding stock section vastly exceeded the performance of 12 months ago. Outside the Paulyn Dispersal there were 31 six-figure transactions compared to 17 in 2012. These played a significant part in improved

figures across the board, with a 60% rise in turnover (again excluding the Paulyn horses) to \in 13,011,600, a 44% rise in average to \in 40,159 and median of \in 14,500 (up 32%). From 387 lots offered, 324, or 84%, were sold--a surge in clearance of ten points. That clearance rate was maintained throughout the second session, which accrued \in 2,033,400 (up 132%), with an average of \in 11,891 (up 62%) and median of \in 8,000 (up 45%). Unsurprisingly, such an upwardly mobile week left Goffs' Group Chief Executive Henry Beeby in a buoyant mood.

"What a thrill. It is hard to describe the feelings we felt at Goffs when the beautiful Chicquita realized all her pre-auction hype with a stunning final bid of \in 6-

million. We have said many times that Goffs exists to sell the very best at every level, and yesterday's incredible scenes are another vindication of our claims to achieve the best for the best, as we don't believe her price has been bettered for a mare or race filly at a European auction. Chicquita was the centrepiece of a remarkable

sale that saw prices of $\in 1.1$ -million, $\in 1$ -million, $\in 850,000$, etc. In fact, there were nine lots over $\in 500,000$, and a massive 49 six-figure lots, which compares most favorably with the 17 at last year's sale. And even without the Paulyn lots there were 31 at $\in 100,000$ or over, which clearly illustrates the massive strides that this sale continues to make year after year."

'UP' TO THE CHALLENGE IN THE JACKPOT

Paul and Andrena Van Doren's **Rise Up** (Rockport Harbor), a runaway winner of the Jean Lafitte S. Oct. 26, dropped the hammer on nine GIII Delta Downs

Jackpot S. rivals en route to a sixlength decision. Sent to the front, the 2-1 shot showed the way through a half mile in :46.30, and turned on the jets in the stretch to win for fun. **Casiguapo**

(Sightseeing), second at 30-1 in the GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga, completed the exacta. It was

another 1 3/4 lengths back to Rankhasprivileges (Einstein {Brz}) in third. Favored Coastline (Speightstown) checked in eighth after stumbling badly at the start. "Down the backside Gerard [Melancon] gave him a breather and that's where the race was won," said Tom Amoss, who saddled Mylute to a thirdplace finish in the 2012 Jackpot. "I've been guilty so many times of taking horses with so much tactical speed and making them something they're not. Maybe I almost did that today, but Gerard took it out of my hands and let him use his speed correctly and got us the win today. So he gets the gold star." Rise Up was previously campaigned by Blazing Meadows Farm LLC and Cottonwood Stables LLC and trained by Timothy Hamm in his first three starts, including a victory in the Mountaineer Juvenile S. Aug. 3. Rise Up disappointed in his first start for these connections with a sixth-place finish at 7-2 in the GIII Iroquois S. at Churchill Sept. 7, but has been unbeatable in a pair of subsequent tries at Delta Downs. 



Final Day Stars...

The Green Desert mare Vastitas (Ire) (lot 1343), with a March cover by hugely promising first-season sire Intense Focus, just had the edge when knocked down to SM Bloodstock for €90,000. From the high-achieving family that includes the unbeaten G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner Treve (Fr) (Motivator {Ire}), the dual winner produced her first foal this year by Dream Ahead, and he was sold in the same ring on Thursday for €58,000 to Marc-Antoine Berghgracht. Next into the arena was 4-year-old Miss Ekaterina (Ire) (lot 1344), by Teofilo (Ire) out of a sister to Kheleyf, who was signed for by Eamonn Reilly of BBA Ireland at €85,000. The Aga Khan's **Sindjara (Include)** (lot 1295) was in the sights of both Bobby O'Ryan and Peter Kelly, but eventually went the way of the latter, representing Emerald Bloodstock, who said: "She's been bought for a client of Jockey Hall Stud, who has bought from the Aga Khan before--something always turns up on those pages and she was a pretty filly." Bought for $\in 61,000$, the 4-year-old relation of dual Derby and Arc winner Sinndar (Ire) won twice for John Oxx, breaking her maiden at the end of her juvenile season when beating recent GI EP Taylor S. winner Tannery (Ire) (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) over a mile on Dundalk's all-weather track. Out of the Lingfield Oaks Trial winner Sindirana (Ire) (Kalanisi {Ire}), Sindjara is a half-sister to maiden winner Sinaniya (More Than Ready), while unraced 2-year-old Sinkal (Smart Strike) holds entries for next year's Derby and Irish Derby and is in training with Dermot Weld.

International Theme Continues...

The second session of the mares' sale may have been conducted in more muted proceedings than the electric

events of Friday, but there were still plenty of international buyers present at Goffs, including Sheikh Mohammed Bin Faleh Al Thani, Chairman of the Qatar Racing and Equestrian Club. He and his team accounted for 11 lots for a total of €178,000,

including Alexander Loyalty (Ire) (lot 1338). The daughter of Invincible Spirit (Ire)--a sister to listed winner Bahama Mama (Ire)--was sold in foal to Bushranger (Ire) by Noel O'Callaghan from Seapark Stud for \in 47,000. Also on the list for Qatar was the Lady Rothschild-bred Lovage (GB) (Exceed And Excel {Aus}), who was offered by Johnstown House Stud carrying her first foal, by Approve (Ire), and cost \in 30,000.

World Map (Ire) Pivotal {GB}) (lot 1355) turns out to be well named, as the Darley filly will have to find her way to Australia, having been bought for a client of New Zealander Paul Moroney. The 3-year-old winner, who has plenty to recommend her as a future broodmare, being out of a half-sister to top-flight Kilfrush Stud winners Sense Of Style (Thunder Gulch) and Valentine Waltz (Ire) (Be My Guest), was bought for €38,000. Moroney also selected a well-bred daughter of Montjeu (Ire) to return to his native country as a breeding prospect when going to €35,000 to secure Clodagh McStay's **Style Is Eternal (Ire)** (lot 1304).

"She's been bought for a client who happens to be in Ireland for the All Blacks [rugby] match," said Moroney. "He's quite new to breeding, but we felt that Montjeu is going to be an outstanding broodmare sire, so he gave me the go-ahead to buy her. She's a lovely filly out of a Classic winner, and her new owner is always trying to buy a Cup horse--hopefully this mare can breed him one."

The late Montjeu shuttled to New Zealand in the early part of his stud career and made quite an impact in the Southern Hemisphere, where his locally-bred Group 1 winners include Wall Street (NZ), Tavistock (NZ), Roman Emperor (NZ) and Nom du Jeu (NZ). He subsequently provided the 2012 Melbourne Cup winner Green Moon (Ire).

Second Career For Tough Valmari...

Valmari (Ire) (Kalanisi {Ire}) was last seen in public when running second to Tara Rose (GB) in a listed mares' steeplechase at Cheltenham in April. Several weeks later she was covered by Azamour (Ire) at Giltown Stud, and then offered for sale on Saturday by Kilnamoragh Stud, selling for \in 50,000 to Bedwin Estates Ltd.

Lot 1285, out of a Soviet Star half-sister to White Muzzle (GB) (Dancing Brave), is nothing if not versatile and durable. Her early days were spent in Greece, where she won four races on the flat at two and three before joining Clive Brittain's Newmarket stable as a 6-year-old, and then switching once again to the jumps yard of Tom Symonds, for whom she won two steeplechases and a hurdle race.



"He's normally not a horse that works real fast, but he seemed enthusiastic out there this morning, and happy." Pletcher continued, "I thought Verrazano and Capo Bastone put in their typical :48 and change half. Both seemed relaxed, happy, and are doing well." "He's not the best work horse in the world, so when he's sharp like that he usually runs good," trainer Dale Romans said.

[Jockey Shaun O'Donnell] just had to be patient from the gate, and the [128 pounds] was a big concern to me, but I'm just over the moon and really pleased. In recording his third-straight Group 1 victory, Buffering asserted his dominance amongst the country's older sprinters. Tried 17 times at the highest level throughout his nearly 40-race career, Buffering finished on the board in that company 10 times, including three times to Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}). The veteran signaled good things were to come this campaign with a strong second place finish to Samaready (Aus) (More Than Ready) in the G1 Moir S. at Moonee Valley Sept. 27, and scored his breakthrough win next out in that track's A\$1-million Manikato S., scraping home by a head. His dominance was much more apparent in the G1 VRC Sprint Classic three weeks ago, when he scored on the front end by a length, giving him his second straight million-dollar race. Buffering, taking up his usual spot at the head of affairs, had to work harder for yesterday's victory. Kept to task early by local favorite Barakey (Aus) (Key Business {Aus}), Buffering disposed of that rival in upper stretch, but had to fend off a late challenge from fellow shipper Moment of Change to go over A\$4million in career earnings. "He's a wee champion; he pushes hard when he is down and out, and they almost had me on the canvas at the 50 meter mark, but he just dug in," winning rider Damian Browne told Racenet.com.au. "He gives his heart when he's down and out. He was able to do a bit but he still found plenty."

A CHANCE AT IMMORTALITY

The Tattersalls December Breeding Stock Sale, to be held in Newmarket Dec. 2-5, will feature some of the most desirable mares in the world. But few can match the star power of British champion **Immortal Verse (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}--Side of Paradise {Ire}, by Sadler's Wells).



The 5-year-old, who sells as <u>lot 1830</u> on Tuesday,

Dec. 3, has the three P's of a top sales prospect: pedigree, performance and presence, and she figures to be among the dearest horses sold in 2013. Immortal Verse famously handed

Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) a one-length defeat in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois in 2011--her second Group 1 tally--and was produced by a stakes-winning half to a horse Americans know best for his win in the 1986 GI Breeders' Cup Mile: Last Tycoon (Ire) (Try My Best). She sells carrying her first foal on an early cover to Dansili (GB).

"She's a very special opportunity," said Luke Lillingston, whose Irish-based Mount Coote Stud has been tabbed to consign the mare. "She has the potential to be an outstanding foundation broodmare for anybody. When one looks back at the top-class fillies and mares that the likes of [Juddmonte's] Khalid Abdullah and Stravros Niarchos bought back in the late 1970s and 1980s, and you see the enormous value they've gotten out of those mares over many, many years--it's remarkable. And she's got a great chance, in the right hands, to found her own dynasty. That's not a ridiculous statement; the family has been incredibly prolific, as anyone can read."

Indeed, the writing was on the wall early on for Immortal Verse. She was purchased by trainer Robert Collet for \in 460,000 at Arqana's August Sale, the thirdhighest-priced Pivotal yearling to sell in 2009 and second-highest filly. Collet bought her for Robert Strauss, in whose green and white colors she won the G2 Prix de Sandringham at Chantilly as a 3-year-old in June of 2011. Immortal Verse continued to build her reputation with swooping, last-to-first win in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot, which left Collet so confident in his charge that he openly predicted victory in the Marois, describing her to the *Racing Post* as, "[O]ut of the ordinary." Few races define a horse's career like the Marois defined Immortal Verse's. Once again at the back of the pack, she made an audacious move to the front up the nearside rail and was always holding the champ at bay.

"She didn't beat Goldikova very far, but there was a key moment when she was going past the line that, if you watch the race, you'll see the jockey [Gerald

Mosse] look around at Goldikova in a slightly cheeky fashion," said Lillingston. "Goldikova has been one of the great champions of recent years, as we all know, and [Immortal Verse] just showed phenomenal acceleration to defeat her, which, in some ways, is the greatest attribute in a Thoroughbred."

For her efforts, Immortal Verse was Britain's highweight 3year-old filly miler in 2011, becoming at least the fifth champion on her catalog page. Her dam

Side of Paradise (Ire), a daughter of Mill Princess (Ire) (Mill Reef), is--in addition to the dual champion Last Tycoon--also a half to the German champion Astronef (Ire) (Be My Guest). Sisters of Side of Paradise, meanwhile, have produced French champion Zipping (Ire) (Zafonic), as well as Grade/Group 1 winners **Sense of Style** (Thunder Gulch) and **Valentine Waltz (Ire)** (Be My Guest).

"It's an extraordinary family going back to Mill Princess and all the great descendants from her," said Lillingston. "She's been an extraordinary blue-hen broodmare, and now, out of it, comes what is probably the most talented of the whole lot, Immortal Verse, who at least you could say is as equally as talented as Last Tycoon."

Lillingston also points out that Dansili, Immortal Verse's covering sire, has worked in the family before, with recent standout and Irish champion Fire Lily (Ire)--a daughter of the Juddmonte sire--on the page.

No surprise given her auction price, Immortal Verse is also a striking individual, says Lillingston. "I was out there looking at her this morning, and you can see why she was so good--let's put it that way," said Lillingston. "She just exudes class. She has just the most beautiful head and eye. She's a very powerful, deep-bodied mare. She stands a little over 16 hands and is very correct, and is a very active, athletic horse. And she has a beautiful disposition. She's the business." **Cont. p12**

Lillingston expects Immortal Verse to draw an international cast of admirers at Tattersalls. "I think the fact that she has fantastic speed and acceleration, and a world-class pedigree, makes her interesting for anybody, anywhere," he said. "I particularly hope she captures the imagination of some people on your side of the pond, because she thoroughly deserves it. I think the overall strength of the Thoroughbred gene pool is very much centered in Europe at the moment. Back in the '50s, the Americans came across the Atlantic and purchased the very best bloodstock they could get their hands on, and founded the modern Thoroughbred in Kentucky, which until relatively recently dominated racing across the world. It's been a long period of investment by European and Middle Eastern interests in American stock, and it will be interesting if someone from your side now grabs the opportunity to bring a world-class prospect back to the United States."

It's safe to say the winning bidder of Immortal Verse won't be faint of heart, and Lillingston said the hugely resurgent commercial market in 2013 should give her buyer confidence.

"Business is back on a global basis," he said. "And with a mare like this, you can't value her over a foal or a couple of foals--though one good colt could pay for the lot. She'll make a lot of money, and this has to be valued as a long-term proposition. But the point is that the future of the business is increasingly bright, and there's plenty to look forward to in the racing and breeding business in the years ahead."

The sale of Immortal Verse also offers a look into the relatively new operation that owns her, Merriebelle Stable. Owned by the Americans John Moores and Charles Noell, Merriebelle made news this past summer when it purchased all the bloodstock of Strauss's Kilfrush Stud in Ireland, including Immortal Verse. (Merriebelle did not purchase the Kilfrush property, which later sold to Qatari interests.) That followed Merriebelle's purchase of Chanteclaire Farm and Stonewall Farm, both in Kentucky.

A resident of San Antonio, Moores is a successful entrepreneur and, along with Noell, founded the venture capital firm JMI Equity. In 1994, he purchased the San Diego Padres. He sold the Major League Baseball team for a reported \$800 million last year. Moores is a noted philanthropist; his \$51 million gift to the University of Houston, his alma mater, in 1991 was the largest in U.S. history for a public university.

Noell is based in Baltimore and is a venture partner at JMI. He also is currently the director of Axeda and ServiceNow, two IT "cloud" companies.
