Tommy Town Thoroughbreds's **Let Faith Arise** (Kafwain) had been knocking on the graded stakes door in her last two, and barged right through yesterday with a convincing success in Santa Anita's GI Santa

Margarita S. Second to Spellbound (Bernardini) in the GII La Canada S. Jan. 19 and to lotapa (Afleet Alex) in the GII Santa Maria S. Feb. 15, the bay was given a 4-1 chance in her first nine-furlong attempt while looking to provide Hall of Famer Jerry Hollendorfer with an initial victory in this event. The homebred attended the pace from the two path before asserting between horses through six panels in 1:11.67. 'Hoppertunity' Comes Knocking cont. from p1 Hoppertunity, a debut fifth behind the promising unbeaten **♂ "TDN Rising Star" ۞** Bayern (Offlee Wild) going seven furlongs at Santa Anita Jan. 4, stretched to a mile with a good-looking maiden win in Arcadia Jan. 30. He fell too far behind early beneath Martin Garcia and finished with interest to come within seven lengths of Intense Holiday (Harlan's Holiday) in the Risen Star. Switching to Mike Smith here, Hoppertunity was in the race from the beginning, and sat in the garden spot in third on the outside behind Strong Mandate (Tiznow) and Ride On Curlin through a half mile in :47.97. He hit the gas on the far turn, effectively keeping Tapiture boxed in, but the GIII Southwest S. hero bulled his way through, while racing shoulder-to-shoulder as they stacked up across the track. Ride on Curlin drifted out and caused a chain reaction in deep stretch, but it only seemed to help Hoppertunity, who came charging widest of all to get the money. "Mike [Smith] said he just started running when he got bumped," assistant trainer Jimmy Barnes said. "That just made him run faster. He's tough. 

Let Faith Arise made her first five starts sprinting on the Golden Gate synthetic, including a debut victory last February, an allowance tally two starts later in April and again two starts after that in June. She took to the dirt to annex Pleasanton's six-furlong California Wine S. on just 13 days rest, but subsequently hit the bench and didn't return until this venue's down-the-hill GIII Senator K. Maddy S. Nov. 2.

She was a close eighth behind Pontchatrain (War Front) that day, but improved her speed figures in both

outings this season and clearly found her niche going long on the

Tommy Tull's Tommy Town Thoroughbreds stands Let Faith Arise's sire Kafwain in Santa Ynez, CA. Tull's operation purchased the winner's dam for \$400,000 at the 2007 Keeneland November sale, and was winning its first-ever Grade I here.

"This is our first Grade I win so it's pretty nice to get this, finally," said Tull, who founded Tommy Town in 2000 with his wife Debi. "I was emotional when they were coming down the stretch. The three of them were hooked up and you just knew something had to give. I thought [lotapa] might keep going but [Let Faith Arise] just dug in and kept going. They're fun."


Close Hatches was working bullets at Payson for her seasonal debut and was backed accordingly. The striking dark bay didn't corner well on the first turn, but

Third last time in the GIII Endeavour S. at Tampa Bay Jan. 25, the dark bay will have the ever-dangerous Gary Stevens in the irons. Wesley Ward sends out Ramsey homebred Emotional Kitten (Kitten's Joy) for her 4-year-old debut in this test. A close second to Emollient in the American Oaks, the chestnut followed that with a third in the GI Del Mar Oaks Aug. 17. Seventh to fellow Ramsey homebred Kitten's Dumplings (Kitten's Joy) in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland Oct. 12, she was last seen winning the GII Mrs. Revere at Churchill Downs Nov. 16 and faces older rivals for the first time here.

MUSHREQ TAKES ROAD LESS TRAVELED

Mushreq (Aus) (Flying Spur {Aus}), still considered a contender for the \$5 million G1 Dubai Duty Free in just under two week's time, will take an unconventional route to that target through today's G3 Abu Dhabi Championship, the closing day Thoroughbred feature of the Abu Dhabi Racing and Equestrian Club. Trained by Mike de Kock for Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Mushreg--winner of last year's G2 Al Fahidi Fort before a 10th-place finish in the Duty Free--won Meydan's Listed Singspiel S. in his seasonal debut Jan. 9. He has failed to find the winner's circle in three attempts since, most recently finishing fifth, beaten 2 3/4 lengths, behind stablemate Vercingetorix (SAf) (Silvano {Ger}) in the G1 Jebel Hatta Mar. 8. Paul Hanagan, stable jockey to Sheikh Hamdan, said: "He won well at the first Dubai World Cup Carnival meeting but things have not really panned out for him since, and we know he is a good horse. It would be nice to think we can still get in the Dubai Duty Free, but he will have to win this well if that was to be the case." Mushreq will have to contend with defending race winner Jutland (GB) (Halling), as well as Start Right (GB) (Footstepsinthesand {GB}), who has recorded a handful of encouraging efforts on the Meydan turf this year.

DERBY 2014 A TWO-HORSE AFFAIR?

The two have dominated the discussion for the better part of four months and they are overwhelming the betting markets, and with the score one race apiece, stablemates Designs On Rome (Ire) (Holy Roman Emperor (Ire) and Able Friend (Aus) (Shamardal) will duke it out over the 2000 meters of today's HK\$16 million (US\$2.06 million) Hong Kong Derby at Sha Tin. Designs On Rome dashed home to win a Class

1 going a mile Nov. 24, but was outfinished by Able Friend in the Hong Kong Classic Mile Jan. 19, dropping a half-length decision. Tommy Berry turned in a worldclass tactical ride on Designs On Rome when the duo rematched in the Hong Kong Classic Cup going nine

furlongs Feb. 23, putting the Joao Moreira-ridden Able Friend to the sword at an early stage and calling that one's stamina into question. Indeed, Designs On Rome proved the better 'stayer' on that occasion, scoring by a decisive 1 1/2 lengths. Berry was en route back to Hong Kong Saturday evening after a day's rides in Australia, and looks forward to this rubber match. "We are on the two best horses in the race," Berry told South China Morning Post. "There's no doubt about that--we beat everything by a distance last start and I can't see anything changing," he said. "But I believe the best horse will win it, and hopefully we both get the right run in the race to decide who that is." For his part, the 'Magic Man' is not ready to concede the race to Designs On Rome. "I don't think there will be any question that he will get the 2000 meters," Moreira asserted. "Looking at his run over 1800 meters, he was able to handle it. I know Designs On Rome beat him, and that horse could and should be suited better by the 2000 meters, but I was pretty happy with his run in the Classic Cup and I don't think 200 meters more will be any problem." Flame Hero (NZ) (Savabeel {Aus}) has plenty to find with the top two, but carries a three-race winning streak off a local rating of 91, some 24 points inferior. He defeated Beauty Flame (Ire) (Footstepsinthesand {GB}) by a head in an 1800-meter handicap Mar. 1 and should be prominent throughout.

GOLD-FUN LOOKS TO ATONE IN OSJC

Pan Sutong's Gold-Fun (Ire) (Le Vie Dei Colori {GB}) looks to snap a mini two-race skid in a salty renewal of the HK\$8-million (US\$1.03 million) Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup at Sha Tin. A handy winner of the G2 Jockey Club Mile Nov. 17, the flashy chestnut was heavily favored in the G1 Hong Kong Mile Dec. 8, but could not resist a sizzling first-up effort from Glorious Days (Aus) (Hussonet) and settled for second. Gold-Fun was expected to rebound in the Stewards Cup going the mile Jan. 19, but he could only finish sixth to the Dubai Duty Free-bound Blazing Speed (GB) (Dylan Thomas (Ire)). Trainer Richard Gibson, who is preparing Akeed Mofeed (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) for a start in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 29, is looking forward to today's recovery mission. "We've been really pleased with Gold-Fun's preparation and I'm delighted with the horse--he's been very receptive to train and we've got him at 100 percent for this race," said Gibson, who has primed Gold-Fun for this test with two barrier trials in the past month. Flagship Shine (Aus) (Tale of the Cat) was on the Derby trail off back-to-back wins over 1400 meters, but was only eighth in the Classic Mile and seventh in the Classic Cup. He cuts back to what might be his best trip here and Joao Moreira gets back in the irons this afternoon. Lucky Nine (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}), seventh to Lord Kanaloa (Jpn) (King Kamehameha {Jpn}) in the G1 Hong Kong Sprint Dec. 8, belied odds of nearly 5-1 to best Charles the Great (Ire) (Holy Roman Emperor (Ire)) in the Chairman's Sprint Prize Feb. 16, with Frederick Engels (GB) (Iceman {GB}) a late-running fourth.

Discreet (Aus) (Shamardal) and a 3/4-brother to GSW Just Discreet (Aus) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}). The winning bidder was Wong Shing Ngai. A pair of offerings shared the second line on final bids of HK\$4.2 million (US\$541,167). Hip 7, the son of High Chaparral (Ire) from the family of top sire Fastnet Rock (Aus), was knocked down to owner Chiu Yung. The bay son of Bombay (Aus) (Encosta de Lago (Aus)) was the most expensive of the Club's yearling purchases at NZ\$480,000 at the NZB Premier Sale. Hip 8 made it a clean sweep for Premier Sale grads, as he was purchased by owner Martin Siu. The NZ\$460,000 buy is a half-brother to two-time Group 1 winners Vision and Power (NZ) (Carnegie {Ire}) and Glamour Puss (NZ) (Tale of the Cat). For the 15 lots, offered without reserve, gross receipts totaled HK\$49.5 million (US\$6,378,044) for an average of HK\$3.3 million (US\$425,203) and a median of HK\$3 million (US\$386,548).

"All in all it was a good sale: we had a couple of sires relatively new to Hong Kong, like the New Approach, so there was a good balance in the catalogue, which gave the buyers plenty of choice," said Bill Nader, the Hong Kong Jockey Club's Executive Director of Racing. "Given the quality of the horses on offer, there was some good value out there, and the hope as always is that these horses will progress well and give the owners customer satisfaction. "The top price was HK\$5.2 million, so it didn't go too high, and I would say the prices throughout the sale were realistic-- hopefully the buyers will come out of it in good shape. We have always said this is not a money-making exercise, that it is about providing quality horses for our members and owners to buy, and overall, if we factor in all the costs around this and last December's sale, it's just about a break even for the Club this season and hopefully a win for the owners." A Claiborne Farm and Adele Dilschneider-bred, Lideris finished strongest down the stretch to outfinish Peruvian Group 1 winner Shakita and Kentucky-bred Azarenka to complete the nation's local dominance in the continental championship. Peruvian Thoroughbreds have won all five renewals of the race staged in Lima.

Bronzo and pacesetter Romaña Ruler finished fourth and fifth, respectively, representing Chile in the 13-runner field that featured five different South American nations. Sao Paulo representative Victory Is Ours refused to load and scratched at the gate.

Considered the weaker entry from the home team, Lideris annexed his fourth career win from 19 starts and first at the highest level here, having previously posted a Group 2 win at 2,400 meters last December.

The winner is owned by businessman Oscar Peña, whose Peruvian dual classic winner Fly Lexis Fly (Badge of Silver) finished second in the 2012 G2 Super Derby and third in last year's G1 Eddie Read S. at Del Mar.
