SOVIET COURAGE (IRE) (2011 g. by Dutch Art (GB)), won 4 races at 3 and 4 years, 2015 at home and in Australia and £83,819 and placed 4 times.

LADY MOSCOU (IRE) (2012 f. by Sir Percy (GB)), won 1 race at 2 years, 2014 and placed 5 times, from only 7 starts.

Nousa Nousa (FR), unraced; dam of **Nuit de Siam (FR)**, winner in France and in U.S.A., third in CTT & T.B. Owners of California Handicap, Del Mar, **L.**

The next dam **PLENCIA (FR)**, won 2 races at 3 years in France including Prix de l'Elevage, Saint-Cloud, **L.**, placed 3 times including second in Prix Francois Andre, Deauville, **L.** and fourth in Prix de Minerve, Chantilly, **Gr.3**;
