MARYLAND JOCKEY CLUB SETS

HANDLE RECORD The Maryland Jockey Club, bolstered by full-card simulcasting and a dramatic increase in out-of-state betting on their races, posted a record in-state handle of \$461,602,755 for 1994. eclipsing the previous mark of \$435,874,022 set in 1990. The total was up 16.1 percent over 1993. Said Maryland Jockey Club President and CEO Joe De Francis, "Racing in Maryland is on the upswing, thanks in part to recent innovations such as off-track wagering, full-card simulcasting and the intertrack wagering agreement with the Marvland Standardbred industry." An additional \$129,680,746 was wagered out-of-state on racing at Laurel and Pimlico, up 39.4 percent over last year. The top jockey on the circuit for 1994 was Mark Johnston with 262 wins; King T. Leatherbury topped the trainers for both victories, with 152, and stakes victories, with 10.

**NEW YORK'S LEADERS FOR '94** Jockey Jorge Chavez, the leading rider at Gulfstream and Hialeah in 1989 and at Calder in 1988, earned his first New York title this year, wrapping up 1994 with a total of 224 victories. He led runner-up Mike Luzzi, in his first year on the New York circuit, by 26 wins. The New York trainers' race went down to the wire, with Gasper Moschera nosing out Hall of Famer Allen Jerkens, 103 to 102. It was Moschera's second straight year on top of the standings.

**PASEANA ON COMEBACK TRAIL** Two-time Eclipse Award winner **Paseana (Arg)** (Ahmad {Arg}) continued to train towards a comeback with her first six-furlong breeze Saturday morning at Santa Anita. With Chris McCarron in the irons, the veteran racemare was clocked in 1:15 over a fast main track. "She's coming along well," said her trainer, Ron McAnally, who added that Paseana's first start back has not yet been decided. "We'll just go day-to-day."
