GULFSTREAM OPENS WEDNESDAY

Gulfstream Park will salute Julie Krone Wednesday when it opens the gates to its 63-day 1995 racing season with free grandstand admission, parking and programs. The day's featured race will be the \$74,955-added GIII Spectacular Bid Breeders' Cup for three-year-olds at six furlongs. A total of 39 stakes-worth a Florida record \$4,625,000--will be decided during the Gulfstream meeting, topped by three Grade I events: the Donn H., the Florida Derby and the Gulfstream Park H. First race post time will be 1 p.m. throughout the meeting ending March 16. Gulfstream will be closed Tuesdays. The most successful woman jockey of all time, Julie Krone, who will handle Mr. Greeley (Gone West) in the Spectacular Bid, is named to ride in nine races on the opening day card. She will be in action for the first time since undergoing surgery Nov. 11 to remove two plates and 13 screws from her reconstructed right ankle, injured in a spill Aug. 30, 1993 at Saratoga. The 31-year-old jockey, Gulfstream's leading rider in 1992 and 1993, will make an appearance at a special "Talk With Julie" half-hour program beginning 11:30 a.m.

STRODES CREEK DRILLS FOR SAN

FERNANDO Strodes Creek (Halo), called "the best horse in the country right now" by his Hall of Fame trainer Charlie Whittingham, worked a flat mile over Santa Anita's fast main track yesterday morning in preparation for the Jan. 14 San Fernando S. The recently-turned four-year-old was clocked in 1:41 1/5 under regular rider Eddie Delahoussaye. "He doesn't work very well alone," Whittingham said, "but it was just about what we needed. It was just an easy mile." The \$200,000 San Fernando, the second leg of the \$800,000 Strub Series, also is expected to attract multiple stakes-winners Wekiva Springs (Runaway Groom), Soul of the Matter (Private Terms), Dramatic Gold (Slew o' Gold) and Dare and Go (Alydar), among others.

JESUS BRACHO BACK IN THE SADDLE On only his first mount back after returning his 1992 Eclipse Award for Outstanding Apprentice Jockey, Jesus Bracho found himself in the winners' circle. Bracho successfully petitioned the state of Florida in October to return his licenses after Calder stewards recommended a lifetime suspension for lying on his original application to ride. Bracho told the stewards in 1991 he had only won three races in his native Venezuela. Records indicated he had actually amassed at least 21 victories over a four year period. The Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering stipulated Bracho must return his Eclipse Award as part of the condition for returning his licenses. He became eligible January 1, 1995 to ride again. On his first mount back in Calder's seventh race vesterday, Bracho rode 3-1 second choice Nezzie Baby to victory. The jockey was greeted by cheers from his countrymen as he entered the winners' circle.
