TORNADO RAVAGES SILVERLEAF

FARM David Hutson's Silverleaf Farm in Summerfield, Florida, sustained major damage from a tornado that touched down early Saturday morning. The stallion barn, breeding shed, a broodmare barn and the maintenance shed were all badly damaged. One mare died in the storm, and three others had to be humanely destroyed. Several mares sustained injuries, but none of the stallions were harmed. "We have had losses in the past, but this is like nothing I have ever experienced," said Hutson, who, with Silverleaf President Bob Cromartie, has already met with an architect to assess damage and begin plans for rebuilding. Plans call for the breeding shed to open as scheduled, but the Silverleaf Stallion Show set for Sunday, January 15, has been cancelled. The tornado which caused the damage at Silverleaf also reportedly killed one man, left 60 injured, and destroyed 150 homes.

FASIG-TIPTON MIXED SALES POSTS MAJOR GAINS Yesterday's Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Winter Mixed Sale showed major increases over 1994, with figures for both gross and average nearly doubling. A total of 143 horses went through the ring, bringing in \$1,258,100; that number was up 93 percent from 1994, when 144 head grossed \$652,800. The '95 average of \$8,798 was up 94 percent from last year. The sales topper was Supah Gem, a five-year-old daughter of Gold Meridian--Jenny's Nandy, by Great Above. The Florida-bred mare, a GISW of \$441,699 consigned by Lane's End, agent, was sold for \$180,000 to Frank Stronach.


SANTA ANITA CANCELS SUNDAY Racing at Santa Anita was called off after the first race Sunday due to what jockeys termed "unsafe" conditions caused by continuing inclement weather. The jockeys, polled by stewards after the day's opener, declined to ride out the remainder of the card. The featured GII San Carlos H. will be redrawn; it has been rescheduled for Saturday, January 14. Santa Anita will apply to the California Horse Racing Board for a make-up day prior to the end of the meet. Racing resumes Wednesday.

HANDLE UP AT TURFWAY'S HOLIDAY

MEET Benefitting from full-card simulcasting and the opening of the track's Race Book, Turfway Park's total wagering for the recently concluded Holiday Meet increased by 44.5 percent, with a record total handle for the 25-day meeting of \$60,985,536. The daily average state-wide handle of \$2,439,421 was up 27 percent from 1993, while daily average statewide attendance, at 8,783, was up 7 percent from a year ago. Total attendance, numbering 219,564, climbed 21 percent over the 22-day meet in '93. Figures on-track increased as well, with the total ontrack handle of \$13,544,081 up 13.5 percent, and total on-track attendance of 85,711 up 14.1 percent. "The figures say to me that the bettors like the new choices we have provided for them," said Turfway President Mark Simendinger. "The Race Book is the centerpiece of our \$5-million improvement program, and the fans clearly like the new facilities that are available to them.'
