#### DEVIL HIS DUE MAY RETURN TO TRAINING

Devil His Due (Devil's Bag) could be back in training at Gulfstream as early as this month, according to trainer Allen Jerkens. The six-year-old horse had been due to stand stud at Buck Pond Farm in Versailles, Kentucky this year for a fee of \$25,000. Owner Edith LiButti is scheduled to appear in court February 6 to settle a dispute with the Internal Revenue Service over the ownership of the horse. The trial date was originally scheduled for Dec. 27, but was postponed when the judge fell ill.

#### HOLY BULL TOPS GLOBEFORM RATINGS

Globeform, the international formbook which lists the top horses racing in England, Ireland, France, Germany, Italy and North America, has released its list of Champions for 1994. The Globeform Horse of the Year is Holy Bull (Great Above), rated at 133 pounds; divisional honorees are: two-vear-old colt--Celtic Swing (GB) (Damister), 129; two-year-old filly--Flanders (Seeking the Gold), 120; three-year-old colt--Holy Bull; three-year-old filly--Balanchine (Storm Bird), 126; older male--Paradise Creek (Irish River {Fr}), 125; older female--Lochsong (GB) (Song {GB}), 125; sprinter--Lochsong; miler--Turtle Island (Ire) (Fairy King {Ire}), 125; middle-distance runner--Tikkanen (Cozzene), 127; and stayer--Bien Bien (Manila), 123. Six of the 10 divisional titles were won by U.S. graded stakes winners, and four by European Group winners.

GO FOR GIN BREEZES Kentucky Derby winner Go For Gin (Cormorant) had his first breeze of the year yesterday morning, working three furlongs in :38 at Gulfstream. "He's doing great," said trainer Nick Zito. "I plan on running him before we leave Gulfstream. He gets himself ready pretty quick. He'll get right on the program now, so it won't be long." Well, she's six-for-six...I don't want to jinx anything."

HOLY BULL WORKS FOR '95 DEBUT Holy Bull (Great Above) worked five furlongs in a bullet :59 2/5 Monday morning at Gulfstream under regular exercise rider Bobby Perna in preparation for his fourvear-old debut Sunday in the Olympic H. "Holy Bull knows something is up," said owner/trainer Jimmy Croll. "He is a little more alert. Right now, I think we are right where we should be. He has done everthing I have wanted him to do coming up to this race. I still think Patton (Lord At War) is the horse to beat. I was hoping Patton would pick up a couple of more pounds, but I understand why he didn't." Patton, second to Holy Bull in the Hutcheson last year, was assigned 115 to Holy Bull's 126. "If I need more than 11 pounds, I shouldn't be in the race," said his trainer, Sonny Hine. Also expected: Birdonthewire (Proud Birdie), who breezed a half-mile in :48 3/5 Monday, galloping out five furlongs in 1:01 2/5. "I couldn't help but be excited about running against a horse like Holy Bull," said trainer Phil Serpe. "We run to win, but let's be realistic. My horse is coming off a long disappointing year."

OCALA MIXED SALE POSTS GAINS The Ocala Breeders' Sales Co. 1995 Winter Mixed Sale, which began yesterday, showed increases in both gross and average for the opening session. A total of 161 horses went through the ring, bringing in a gross of \$2,149,200, which was up nearly 30 percent over the '94 opener when 136 head sold for \$1,654,600. The '95 average, \$13,349, was up almost 10 percent over the '94 figure of \$12,166. Glen Hill Farm sold the session topper, five-year-old Fast Asset (Shahrastani); unraced, the mare is a half-sister to four stakes winners, including Earn Your Stripes (Little Current), MSW, \$395,058; Major Impact (Roberto), SW, \$518,138; and Concept Win (Manila), GSW, \$320,750. John Sikura purchased the Florida-bred for \$75,000.

LAWRENCE ENSOR JR. DEAD AT 67 Lawrence E. Ensor, Jr., a senior officer and director of Fasig-Tipton, died suddenly in Petersburg, Virginia Sunday while traveling to Florida.
