HOLY BULL TO STUD IN '95 Holy Bull

(Great Above) will be shipped to Jonabell Farm in Lexington, Kentucky in as few as three weeks and will be booked to as many as 50 mares this spring, according to farm president Jimmy Bell. "As far as the breeding season, he's not missed as much time as you might think," said Bell. "There were a lot of people who said 'just let us know where and when.' There has been as much interest in breeding to this horse as there have been people wanting to watch him run. There are a lot of horses who are regally bred and do not display the courage and the class and the charisma that this horse exudes." Holy Bull walked briefly and was hosed Sunday morning. "I'm just so relieved that he's no worse than he is," said owner/trainer Jimmy Croll. "It was a terrible thing to happen, but I was so happy he was standing on all fours." An ultrasound Sunday morning revealed no major tears in the superficial flexor tendon, which Dr. Peter Hall said was merely strained. "I can't demonstrate any ruptures," said Hall. "The ultrasound shows lesions starting at the knee and going to the ankle where the tendon attaches to the pastern bone. It is a reparable type of lesion. Some horses with this exact injury could go back to racing. He's going to be healthy and sound in 30 days. He'll be out in the field, running around."

DONN WRAP-UP Donn H. winner Cigar (Palace Music) came out of the race in good order and will be pointed for another start at Gulfstream Park. "We'll find out if he can handle a mile and a quarter in the GI Gulfstream Park H. (March 5) and that will determine our plans for later in the year," said his trainer, Bill Mott. "He has a chance to go on and be a lot of fun." Runner-up Primitive Hall (Dixieland Band) also is doing well, and could make his next start in the Gulfstream Park H., the GIII Creme Fraiche H. (March 11), or the Ft. Lauderdale H. (March 11). Virginia Rapids (Riverman), seventh in the race, was found to have bled and will run on Lasix in his next start, which has not yet been determined.

There were a couple of people connected with the Triple Crown in the paddock saying, 'Listen, you've got to take over the mantle now. We need a star to come in after what happened (to Holy Bull).' That's an awful lot of heat to feel." According to trainer Richard Mandella, the colt is possible for the San Rafael S. (March 4), but is more likely to await the San Felipe S. (March 19). "He's had his little rest and now we're in a building process to get to the Derby," he said.
