#### GULFSTREAM INCREASES OVERNIGHT

PURSES All Gulfstream Park overnight purses will be increased by approximately five percent, effective February 25, Track President and CEO Douglas Donn announced yesterday. "The additional money available for purses is due to the excellent response to our national simulcasting network," Donn said. Bob Umphrey, Gulfstream director of racing, stated the increase will run through closing day, March 16.

EXPLOSIVE RED BACK IN ACTION Trainer Danny Vella said Monday morning that five-year-old Explosive Red (Explodent) will miss the Feb. 25 Gulfstream Park Budweiser Breeders' Cup, but is nearing his 1995 debut at Gulfstream. The 1993 Grade I Hollywood Derby winner suffered a condylar fracture of his left front cannon bone early last year and hasn't raced since. His other graded stakes tallies include the GII American Derby at Arlington and the GIII Forerunner S. at Keeneland for earnings to date of \$863,931. "He is 100 percent sound right now and he appears as willing as ever," said Vella. "There are a lot of intangibles that we won't find out about until we run. We were hoping to run (in the GII Gulfstream Budweiser BC), but he got a little more tired than we expected in his last couple of works. We are biding our time until he is 100 percent fit." Explosive Red is scheduled to breeze over the Gulfstream turf Wednesday.

**HUFF APOLOGIZES TO CHARLES TOWN** TRACK PRESIDENT West Virginia Breeders' Classics President Sam Huff, who threatened to move the West Virginia Breeders' Classics to Mountaineer Park last week after Middleburg, Virginia businessman Jim Wilson lost out to Showboat Operating Company in a bid to buy the Charles Town Races, offered his apologies to track President D. Keith Wagner yesterday and pledged his continued support for racing at the Thoroughbred track. Huff criticized Wagner in a Friday press conference, claiming that the track owners rejected Wilson's \$12.5 million purchase offer. As Huff was addressing members of the media, track officials were announcing that Showboat had purchased an option to buy the track for \$18 million after Wilson declined to buy the track outright. "I'm afraid my emotions just got the best of me before I became aware of what they were trying to do," said Huff Monday. "I called Keith (Wagner) this morning and told him I was way out of line the other day and I wanted to be part of the solution at the track, not part of the problem. He said he could understand my disappointment and graciously accepted my apology. Huff indicated that any decision to move the Classics, West Virginia's richest night of racing, would require board approval. "I'm just one member of the board and I clearly overstepped my authority," said Huff.
