LUKAS SUSPENDED 60 DAYS Trainer D. Wayne Lukas has been handed a 60-day suspension for the September 17, 1994 post-race Isoxsuprine positive of juvenile filly champion Flanders at Belmont Park. The disciplinary action was announced yesterday by the New York State Racing and Wagering Board, which stated that their attempts to obtain additional information regarding the drug finding, which was disputed by the filly's owners, had been unsuccessful. Recent Isoxsuprine positives in other racing jurisdictions have resulted in much lighter penalties--trainer Susan Walsh was not fined or suspended for a positive in Massachusetts, and several Florida trainers have been absolved in similar cases; trainer Vince Timphony was fined \$2,000 for a positive finding in California. Lukas' attorney Joel Turner said the suspension would be appealed.

HOLLYWOOD WILDCAT RETIRED Hollywood Wildcat (Kris S.) has been retired following an injury to the tendon in her left front leg and will be shipped to Kentucky to begin a new career as a broodmare. Said co-owner Irving Cowan, "I wouldn't want to do anything at this point to jeopardize the brilliant career she has already had. She's just been too nice a filly. When we get to Kentucky, we'll reassess (the injury), but right now, our feeling is that she's retired." Cowan added that it has not yet been decided who Hollywood Wildcat will be bred to; the champion three-year-old filly of 1993 retires with a record of 12 wins from 21 career starts and \$1,432,160 in earnings. She won her lone start this year, the Little Brianne S. at Santa Anita February 10.

WALLEDA INJURED Dogwood Stable's Wallenda (Gulch) has suffered a torn superficial flexor tendon in his left front ankle and may be retired. The five-year-old, a Grade I stakes winner of \$1,205,929, was injured while galloping at Calder earlier this week; an ultrasound examination Thursday revealed the tear. "While the ultrasound material has been shipped to Kentucky for opinions from two other veterinarians, it is clear that his future as a racehorse is bleak," said Dogwood manager Cot Campbell. "We are going to begin discussions concerning his stud career as quickly as possible."

HOLLYWOOD ANNOUNCES 1995 STAKES SCHEDULE

A total of \$10,125,000 in stakes purses will be offered at the 1995 spring/summer and autumn meetings at Hollywood Park. An addition to the summer meet is the newly named Caesars Palace Turf Championship, second leg of a two-race East-West turf series. Formerly the GI Hollywood Turf H., the race has been moved to Saturday, July 22; in an agreement between Hollywood, Caesars Palace and Caesars World, and Atlantic City Race Course, a sweep of the \$500,000 event and the \$500,000 Caesars International at Atlantic City June 25 would earn the winning owner a \$425,000 bonus and a total of \$1 million. In other schedule changes, the purse for the GI Swaps S. has been raised \$300,000 to \$500,000 this year; the race, set for July 23, has also been shortened to a mile and an eighth. The Turf Festival, highlight of the autumn schedule, will consist of six grass stakes worth \$2 million to be run over Thanksgiving weekend. It will culminate in the GI Matriarch, which will be run at the longer distance of a mile and a quarter for an increased pot of \$700,000 November 26. The spring/summer season runs April 28 through July 24 and boasts eight Grade I events; the fall meet, November 15 through December 24, features five Grade I races.

CALIFORNIA TRACKS TO OFFER PARLAYS

Win, place and show parlay wagering will be offered on all races at Santa Anita and Golden Gate Fields beginning Wednesday, it was announced yesterday. The minimum \$2 wager can encompass as many as six races at either track, but cannot include races from both tracks. Special bet cards will be available for the wager, and winnings from each race will be bet on the next leg of the parlay even when payoff amounts do not round off to a dollar.
