"It was probably the best I have ever seen him work," said Baker. "He is doing really good right now. I have always liked this horse. He needs a distance and he needs pace; he doesn't always get it, but when he does you see the real horse." Ninth in last year's Kentucky Derby, the colt wrenched an ankle in the race and has run just twice since; he captured his last start, the Diplomat Way H. January 28, and is now four-for-nine lifetime.
