JULIE KRONE BACK IN THE SADDLE Jockey Julie Krone, idle since breaking her left hand in a January 13 spill at Gulfstream Park, climbed aboard three horses Friday morning for the first time since the accident. Krone galloped one horse and breezed another for trainer Scotty Schulhofer and galloped a third for trainer Dave Donk at Gulfstream. "It went really well," said Krone, who added that it felt "great" to be riding again. The pin was removed from Krone's left hand February 16, and follow-up MRIs on both hands showed contusions but no soft tissue damage. For now, Krone won't pinpoint a return to afternoon competition. "I'm going take it day by day," she said.

DARE AND GO PREPS FOR BIG 'CAP Dare And Go (Alydar) worked a mile over a sloppy Santa Anita main track late Friday morning, getting the distance in 1:40 3/5 and galloping out nine furlongs in 1:54 4/5. The four-year-old was caught in fractions of :12 3/5, :25 4/5, :38 2/5, :50 4/5, 1:03, 1:15 1/5, and 1:28 2/5; he earned his first career dirt victory in the GI Strub S. last time out.

#### FLITCH ON TRACK FOR FLORIDA DERBY

Flitch (Demons Begone) breezed five furlongs in 1:01 2/5 under jockey Mike Smith at Gulfstream Park yesterday; trainer Bill Badgett confirmed that the half-brother to Prairie Bayou will make his next start in the GI Florida Derby March 11. An allowance winner last time out, Badgett expects improvement from his charge. "The farther he goes--it will be in his favor," he remarked. "He probably did more than he was supposed to at two. He was a late foal and he was big and awkward. Maturing physically and mentally has helped him quite a bit."

#### HISHI AMAZON TO SANTA ANITA MONDAY

Assuming she clears quarantine at Hollywood Park, Hishi Amazon (Theatrical {Ire}) is scheduled to arrive at Santa Anita Monday. The Japan-based filly, who has bankrolled more than \$4.8 million, will be stabled with trainer Richard Mandella's string and will be handled by Dent Caton as she trains for the \$150,000a Santa Ana H. March 18.
