Trainer Gary Jones, who saddled Stuka to win this race last year after The Wicked North was disqualified from first to fourth, sends out longshot Puzar (Herat). Making the decision to take a shot at the million-dollar event, Jones scratched the four-year-old from an allowance Thursday. "He's owned by some people (Allen Paulson and Prestonwood Farm) who are pretty game," said Jones. "We had paid our nomination fees...and who knows what the weather's going to do between now and then? Best Pal (*Habitony) has never been a great mud horse...l don't even know if my horse likes the mud. But I'd rather take a shot for a million than not." The colt, first or second in five of eight career starts, has never raced over a muddy track, never been beyond a mile and a sixteenth, and finished seventh in his only try against stakes horses in the GIII Lazaro S. Barrera H. last November. He makes his first start off a two-month break.

Four of the three-year-olds entered have earned a 100 or better BRIS Speed Rating in their previous effort, a mark we like to use in races like this to distinguish the true runners. Another factor we examine is class, as measured by our predictive Class Ratings. Another factor that merits weight in the Triple Crown preps is late Pace Ratings, a measure of who is running the fastest at the end of the race.

Using these criteria, we have narrowed this field down to four contenders (in order of preference).

Jambalaya Jazz (Dixieland Band) broke poorly in the Fountain of Youth, made a determined run midway through the race, then flattened out to finish third. Improving works point to a better race today--if he avoids trouble.

Thunder Gulch (Gulch) got a dream trip last time out and has proven he can win at this distance. He has the best late Pace Ratings in the field and should be full of run at the end.

Star Standard (Risen Star) owns a victory (via disqualification) over Jambalaya Jazz at this meet and has won at this distance. He has run on or near the lead in his last few starts, but his late Pace Ratings indicate he would adjust well in a closer's role.

Suave Prospect's (Fortunate Prospect) Speed Rating line reads 86-95-101-104-106, meaning he has improved from a good allowance-level competitor to a top-class stakes horse. We expect his bubble to burst soon, though, as the average winning distance for foals of Fortunate Prospect is only 6.6 furlongs.
