THUNDER STRIKES TWICE Holding on

gamely to the claim as the East's top Triple Crown contender, Thunder Gulch (Gulch) earned his second straight Florida stakes win with a determined nose victory over rival Suave Prospect (Fortunate Prospect) in vesterday's GI Florida Derby at Gulfstream Park. As they did in the Fountain of Youth three weeks ago, the pair hooked up at the top of the stretch and battled head-and-head down the lane, with the Team Lukas runner once again proving narrowly best. It was the first Florida Derby victory for trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "I'm gonna get all of these stakes knocked out if I live long enough," said Lukas. "Right now, (Thunder Gulch) is king of the hill in the East. He took a big step forward today; I just didn't expect Suave Prospect to take the same step. Obviously, these two are going to hook up down the line." Trainer Nick Zito, who had to settle for second once again, said, "It was a tough beat. He got every break--he got through on the rail. I've got to give the other horse credit. He just ran me down." The two colts will meet again in the Blue Grass S. April 15.

FLANDERS RETIRED As expected, Eclipse Award winner Flanders (Seeking the Gold) has been retired, trainer D. Wayne Lukas confirmed yesterday. Lukas said it is "likely" that the Breeders' Cup champion will be bred to Rahy within a month. "Everyone was interested in breeding her to Seattle Slew, but we were concerned that the foal would be too big and it would tear her up because she's so young," said Lukas. "With Rahy, we're hoping for a smaller foal."

### **BAILEY BREAKS GULFSTREAM RECORD**

Jockey Jerry Bailey became the first jockey ever to win seven races on one card at Gulfstream Park yesterday, accomplishing the feat in the day's last race aboard the Team Lukas trainee Heavy Rain. Ironically, it was the Lukas-trained Thunder Gulch who denied Bailey what would have been his seventh win with Suave Prospect in the GI Florida Derby. "I had a great day, but I didn't win the race I really wanted to win," he said. "I wasn't even thinking about breaking the record. I was focused in on the Derby. I feel that I have had an excellent meet overall--and it all just came together today. I have to give my agent, Bob Frieze, a lot of credit. Obviously, this is a big thrill."

Jockey Gary Stevens, who shipped in from Hong Kong for the race, said, "I wouldn't have gotten on a plane for 12 hours if I didn't love him.
