FLORIDA DERBY WRAP-UP Winner Thunder Gulch (Gulch) will fly back to California Tuesday to await his next engagement, the Blue Grass S. at Keeneland April 15. "He came out of the race in good shape," said Todd Pletcher, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "He was on his toes as he marched around this morning. It doesn't appear to have knocked him down one bit." Suave Prospect (Fortunate Prospect) also came out of the race in good order and will point to the Blue Grass as well; trainer Nick Zito is looking forward to a rematch. "It was interesting to see the paper this morning," he said. "I was surprised to see what Wayne said. He said he would eventually break Suave Prospect's heart and that he has my colt's number. I'm sure Wayne will break a lot of hearts--Suave Prospect's will not be one of them." Longshot Mecke (Maudlin), third at 22-1 Saturday, will travel to Keeneland for another run at the top two. "This is the best shot I've ever had at the Kentucky Derby and the farther the better," said his trainer, Manny Tortora. "This is a nice horse. He has good breeding on both sides and he wants two turns. I don't know why people don't like him." Said John Ward, trainer of sixth-place finisher Jambalaya Jazz (Dixieland Band), "I think it was just too many races, too close together. We'll take five weeks off and look at the Blue Grass in our own backvard." Also continuing on the Triple Crown trail, Flitch (Demons Begone), fourth, will go in either the Blue Grass or the Wood Memorial at Aqueduct the same day; Oliver's Twist (Horatius), fifth, will head for the Federico Tesio S.; and Kresa (Blushing John) could start next in the Wood Memorial with blinkers added.

BEST PAL TO OAKLAWN Multi-millionaire Best Pal (*Habitony), who finished fast to be second in the GI Santa Anita H., could come back in the \$750,000 Oaklawn H. April 15. The seven-year-old won the event in 1992. "He came out of the race real good," said trainer Richard Mandella. "Best Pal really ran great, I thought. But still, because this is the Handicap, it leaves you a little disappointed because you didn't win it. I have to be honest there, but I couldn't be more proud of my horse. We're looking at the Oaklawn H. next." Plans for Mandella's Dare and Go (Alydar), third in the Big 'Cap, are still undecided. News cont. p2

With another gutsy performance for a Team Lukas runner, Serena's Song picked up her second Grade I win of the year. The classy filly shadowed Mari's Sheba to the far turn, moved to the lead as they straightened for home, and dug down deep to hold off the late charge of Urbane. "The track is real soft and deep today," said winning jockey Corey Nakatani. "I thought I was going to win the race by 10 or 15 lengths, then, all of a sudden, she started laboring on it. I thought my filly just ran a huge race considering the way the track is playing. When Urbane came up to her, my filly kicked again--that's just the class in her." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas said the filly would probably race once more before the Kentucky Oaks, mentioning the Ashland at Keeneland April 22, the Fantasy S. at Oaklawn April 14, or even the Jim Beam S. at Turfway April 1. Said Lukas before the Santa Anita Oaks, "It depends on who shows up (in the Jim Beam), but I'm looking at a \$600,000 purse, and how many times does a filly get to run for that much money?'
