TRA ENDS NATIONAL BEST SEVEN The Thoroughbred Racing Associations announced yesterday that it has decided to cancel the National Best Seven due to insufficient handle to support the production and distribution costs and associated television presentation. The final National Best Seven will be conducted April 8, when there will be a payout of all carryover pools. The 40 National Best Sevens which have been offered generated a total handle of \$8,635,045, averaging \$215,876 each. The bet was created to fund the office of the TRA Commissioner.

HANDLE UP AT GULFSTREAM MEET Gulfstream Park concluded its 1995 season Thursday, showing a 10.9 percent increase in total handle but a slight .8 percent decrease in attendance. The total handle for '95 was \$622,039,403 for the 63-day meet; the daily average of \$9,873,641 was up 9.1 percent from last year. A total of 662,499 visited the track this year for an average of 10,516 as compared to 10,603 in 1994. "The national demand for Gulfstream's racing product resulted in a continuation of the upward trend of wagering on our simulcasting network," said President and CEO Douglas Donn. "The Gulfstream management and staff have targeted, among other initiatives for 1996, further expansion of its patron services, continuation of its yearly facilities improvements program and again presenting world-class championship racing."

PROBLEMS FOR FURIOUSLY Furiously (Danzig), standing his first year at stud at Vinery in Midway, Kentucky, has been experiencing difficulties getting his mares in foal, according to Ben P. Walden, Jr., the farm's owner. Said Walden, "This is a disappointing development and a baffling one in that he is a vigorous breeder and tests extremely well under microscope. We immediately summoned Dr. Charles Love, the eminent equine reproductive specialist from New Bolton. His initial findings are quite positive, but we won't have a complete report for several days. In the interim, we felt the responsibility of giving breeders who have booked to the horse the opportunity to make other arrangements, although some plan to continue breeding to him in the hope all this sorts out."

"I wish we'd have gotten a full field," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who saddles champion **Timber Country** (Woodman). "You'd get a more honest pace and probably a truer race. PIMLICO ANNOUNCES STAKES SCHEDULE

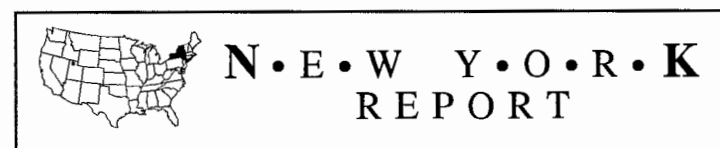
Pimlico Race Course, America's second oldest track, will celebrate its 125th anniversary with a stakes schedule worth more than \$3.4 million. Highlighted by the second jewel of the Triple Crown, the GI Preakness set for May 20, the schedule includes nine graded events; the GI Pimlico Special (May 13), the Preakness and the GII Early Times Dixie H. (May 20) will be televised live on ABC Sports. The 50-day Pimlico Spring meet begins Tuesday, April 4 and runs through Sunday, June 11. Live racing will be conducted Thursdays through Sundays as well as Tuesdays; the track will be open Wednesdays for simulcasting.

KEIO HAI SPRING CUP INVITATIONS OUT

The Japan Racing Association has announced the list of five foreign participants selected for this year's 40th Keio Hai Spring Cup. There were only two nominees from the U.S., and neither made the list; invited to the race, set for April 22, are: **Emperor Jones** (Danzig) (United Arab Emirates), **Erin Bird** (Bluebird) (GB), **Faltaat** (Mr. Prospector) (UAE), **Heart Lake** (Nureyev) (UAE) and **Poetic King** (Yeats) (Aust).
