"It's very gratifying to beat a horse of that quality. I have a world of respect for Timber Country; he ran a nice race today. But I wouldn't trade mine for anybody in the world, believe me. We're just praying he stays as good as he is, because I don't think he could get much better." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas, pleased with his colt's performance, said, "The road gets steeper and the races get longer. I think both horses will improve off this race--I know mine will." The colts will likely meet again in the Santa Anita Derby April 8, although Mandella did mention the Blue Grass as a possible "back-up plan."
