Day and Katsumi Minai, from Japan, dead-heated for second with 30 points. Chris McCarron, last year's individual winner, finished among the also-rans with 17 individual points. Rounding out the team standings were Japan with 43 points and Australia with 27.

SCHEDULE Calder Race Course will offer over \$5 million in stakes purses during the Calder and Tropical-at-Calder meets in 1995, it was announced yesterday. Calder opens for racing May 25. Calder's Festival of the Sun, the richest day in Florida racing, will be held Sat., Sept. 30, and offers six stakes races, including the finals of the Florida Stallion Stakes for two-year-old colts and fillies, worth \$400,000 each.

He will stand for a fee of \$1,000 live foal.
