CHRB CONSIDERS MEDICATION

POLICY The California Horse Racing Board is "developing a policy that acknowledges authorized levels for specific therapeutic medications necessary for the maintenance of the health and welfare of the horse," it was announced Friday. Pointing to the fact that improved testing methods have resulted in the detection of therapeutic medications below their beneficial levels, the CHRB's Medication Committee has proposed an amendment which would recognize eight substances: acepromazine, mepivacaine, promazine, albuterol, atropine, benzocaine, procaine, and salicylates; authorized trace levels of these medications in urine samples would be established and a positive test below the established level would not be considered a violation. No blood plasma levels would be allowed under the regulation. "Basically, there are three ways to deal effectively with this issue," said CHRB Executive Director Roy Wood. "One method, as suggested by the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association, would be to have a veterinary consultant...review certain cases and make recommendations as to whether administrative action should be taken. A second method would be to set threshold levels at the laboratories. We prefer the third method, which is to establish in rule form urinary levels for therapeutic drugs to assist the industry in caring for the horse. We have developed this rule with considerable input from the racing industry." In addition, the CHRB has moved to establish an administrative policy which will provide stewards with more comprehensive guidelines for consideration of mitigating circumstances, such as thirdparty tampering and environmental or accidental contamination, in medication violations.

James Bond charge to sit closely behind a fast pace and take over turning for home.

Da Hoss was extremely impressive in the GIII Best Turn S. in his latest and has pleased his conditioner with solid works since that win. His ability to come from off the pace may be utilized here, since a very fast pace is anticipated based on BRIS Pace Ratings.

Ave's Flag (Personal Flag) is capable of making an impact, but does not figure to threaten the top choice. Consider in the exotics.

Canadian champ Talkin Man (With Approval) faces a tremendous hurdle against a tough field off a layoff and packing top weight. Mike Smith stays in the irons, but the colt is likely to be short today.
