FRENCH DEPUTY INJURED Three-year-old French Deputy (Deputy Minister), who was scheduled to make his stakes debut in the Rebel S. at Oaklawn this Saturday, April 1, may miss the race due to a bruised right front foot. "I have no idea how much time this might cost him," said his trainer, Neil Drysdale. "It could be two days; it could be longer." The colt made his last start at Santa Anita February 23, winning a mile allowance event by an impressive 11 lengths.

DEFRERE SHARP FOR BAHAMAS Defrere (Deputy Minister), the full brother to champion Dehere who opened eyes with an impressive maiden score at first asking, breezed a strong five furlongs in :59 2/5 at Palm Beach Downs Saturday and remains on target for the Bahamas S. at Hialeah April 16. "He's been training super," said his conditioner, Reynaldo Nobles. "I'm going to take it nice and slow with him. I'm going to let him mature. If everything goes perfect, maybe we'll run him in the Travers at Saratoga. I'm going to stay away from the Triple Crown."
