

LIBUTTI DECISION POSTPONED The trial pitting owner Edith LiButti versus the Internal Revenue Service over ownership of **Devil His Due** (Devil's Bag) concluded yesterday. However, Judge Thomas McAvoy did not issue a ruling. According to Matt Magnone, district counsel for the IRS in New Jersey, the judge asked that both sides file briefs by the end of April. At that time, McAvoy will take the case under advisement and said he will rule on it as soon as possible. With the Devil set to make his six-yearold debut in the Westchester H. at Aqueduct today, the matter is far from resolved. Even after a ruling is made, the losing side is likely to issue an appeal. The IRS has alleged that LiButti's father, Ralph, is the actual owner of the horse and has placed a lien on him to collect back taxes owed by the elder LiButti.

CIGAR PREPS FOR OAKLAWN H. Cigar (Palace Music) breezed six furlongs at Gulfstream Park yesterday in preparation for the April 15 Oaklawn H., where he will bid for his sixth straight victory since being switched to the dirt. "He went an easy three-quarters in 1:13 and change," said Ralph Nicks, assistant to trainer Bill Mott. "He's scheduled to ship to Oaklawn (Saturday)." The five-year-old comes into the race off a pair of Gulfstream Grade I wins, the Donn H. and the Gulfstream Park H.

ARNOLD WINICK DIES IN FLORIDA Trainer Arnold Winick, who saddled Hold Your Peace to win the 1972 Flamingo S., died of natural causes Thursday night in Hollywood, Florida. He was 67. Winick dominated the Florida circuit in the 1960's and early 70's, winning a record 12 training titles at Gulfstream as well as three titles at Hialeah and two at Calder. Funeral arrangements are still pending.

BRIS ANALYSIS

Typically, Jim Beam success comes to a runner who is a proven winner, breaking from one of the three inside posts, and shipping in from a major racing circuit. All recent Beam winners have demonstrated the ability to run triple digit BRIS Speed Ratings, so the pendulum clearly swings in favor of **Serena's Song** (Rahy). Trainer D. Wayne Lukas has won other Derby preps in the past with hard-knocking fillies such as Althea and Winning Colors; Serena's Song has already won four Grade I's and her ability to rate makes her extra dangerous in here.

Based on the BRIS Pace Ratings, **Mecke** (Maudlin) has more early speed than most handicappers realize. Florida shippers have won two recent runnings of the Beam, and this colts exits a strong performance in the tough Florida Derby. He is also the only member of the field with a win at nine furlongs.

Devil's Brew (Devil's Bag) is the prime candidate to improve, considering he runs at equal weights, has a race over the track and gets extra ground to mount his Whirlaway finish.

Tejano Run (Tejano) has the dangerous money rider Jerry Bailey in the irons, but a good effort is all his trainer is looking for today--not worth a bet at short odds.

Today's Bet: Box Serena's Song in exactas with Mecke and Devil's Brew.

River Flyer (Riverman), making his first appearance since taking the GII San Marcos H., is undefeated in three starts at Santa Anita. The consistent **Savinio** (The Minstrel), who has picked up checks his last nine starts, will benefit from an honest early pace.
