SERENA REIGNS SUPREME IN JIM

BEAM Becoming the first filly ever to win the race, odds-on favorite Serena's Song (Rahy) proved more than the boys could handle in yesterday's GII Jim Beam S. at Turfway. Running her win streak to five, the talented bay led from gate to wire to win as much the best. "She's as tough as they come," said her jockey, Corey Nakatani. "I didn't think she could get beat. She's as tough as nails. She's got speed, she can sit second--you can do whatever you want with her." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who already has two top Triple Crown prospects in Timber Country (Woodman) and Thunder Gulch (Gulch), said after the race that Serena's Song would be back against fillies for her next start, pointing for the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland April 22, but that the Kentucky Derby has not been completely ruled out. Lukas saddled the last distaff Derby winner, Winning Colors in 1988.

SIMULCASTING SCHEDULE SET FOR

RETAMA PARK Retama Park, which opens for its inaugural live racing meet April 7, will also offer a broad range of simulcast racing beginning April 12. The track will receive the signals from Aqueduct, Churchill Downs, Delaware, Garden State, Hialeah, Keeneland, Louisiana Downs, Oaklawn, Penn National, Philadelphia, Pimlico, Santa Anita, Sportsman's, Suffolk Downs and Trinity Meadows; racing fans at the newest Texas track will be able to watch and wager on the action from six or seven of these tracks daily. In addition, 58 outlets have contracted to take Retama Park's signal.

ANOTHER RECORD FOR HIALEAH For the third consecutive weekend, the total handle for a single card at Hialeah has set a record. The total handle for Saturday's program was a record \$8,421,464, breaking the previous mark of \$8,001,115 set last Saturday, March 25.

Showing her speed right out of the gate, favored Serena's Song was pressed by MIGHTY MAGEE (Cormorant) through the opening fractions but shook off that challenger on the far turn and pulled away down the lane to win as much the best. "I think she is probably the best filly I ever rode, and the best filly we've seen in a long time," said rider Corey Nakatani. "She goes out there and takes the heart out of the other horses." Runner-up Tejano Run, recently recovered from a lung infection, finished well and will continue on the Triple Crown trail, coming back in the Blue Grass S. April 15. Said his jockey, Jerry Bailey, who is committed to ride Cigar in the Oaklawn H. that day, "The owners told me that I can have the mount in the Derby if he runs. He will be very, very tough in the Blue Grass. I wish I could ride him.'
