SANTA ANITA DERBY NOTES Early Santa Anita Derby favorite **Afternoon Deelites** (Private Terms) breezed six furlongs in 1:14 1/5 at Santa Anita yesterday with exercise rider Francisco Alvarado in the irons. "He went great," said his trainer, Richard Mandella. "We got him to slow down. He went his half in :50, then he went an eighth in :11 and change and out three-quarters in :13, so he went perfect. We got him to settle, which we wanted to do." Trainer Randy Bradshaw said Sunday that Louisiana Derby winner **Petionville** (Seeking the Gold) is now probable for the Santa Anita Derby. "We'll enter and take a look," he said, "but if he draws an outside post position, I'll decide whether or not to run. I don't want to have to rush him from the outside. If he draws a bad post, it could compromise his chances." Bradshaw's alternative would be the Wood Memorial at Aqueduct April 15. The undefeated colt is scheduled to work five furlongs this morning. **Lake George** (Vice Regent) is set to work a half today, and **Timber Country** (Woodman) is also possible for the work tab. **Larry The Legend** (Local Talent) and **Jumron** (GB) (Sharpo {GB}) are expected to breeze Tuesday, and **Fandarel Dancer** (Marshua's Dancer) will stretch his legs Thursday. Post time for the first race on the Santa Anita Derby card will be noon; the Santa Anita Derby, set to go off at 2:20 p.m. PDT, will be televised on ABC Sports, going out live on the East coast and tape-delayed locally.

CANADIAN CHAMPS READY TO RETURN

Trainer Dan Vella, who campaigns **King Ruckus** (Bold Ruckus), last year's top Canadian sprinter and older horse; and **Honky Tonk Tune** (Cure the Blues), Canada's champion two-year-old filly for '94, said Sunday that his two Sovereign Award winners will be back in action this month. Both have been away since finishing off the board in their respective Breeders' Cup races last November. "King Ruckus stayed in Kentucky after the Breeders' Cup and was turned out until the first of January. After that, he came to Florida for some serious training," said Vella. "Right now, it looks like he is right on line for the Jacques Cartier S. (April 9 at Woodbine)." Honky Tonk Tune is expected to make her seasonal bow in the Star Shoot S. at the Toronto oval April 22.

Del Mar Dennis earned his first stakes win in this event a year ago at better than 8-1. Sent off the odds-on choice to make it two in a row, the chestnut gelding jumped out to a clear lead after a half-mile and steadily increased the margin to win as much the best in an impressive effort. "This is one of his best races," said trainer Paco Gonzalez. "This is the best he's ever been, I think. He came out of the Santa Anita H. (4th) in really good shape. His feet are perfect now and, of course, this was not the same field as the Santa Anita H. You've got to say that, too." As for the future, Gonzalez said, "We'll see how he comes out. Probably a race at Hollywood, or maybe (owner John Toffan) wants to run him in the Pimlico Special (May 13). But I'd like to give him a little time. He's already run five tough races this year." Said winning jockey Chris Antley, "It was almost like a morning workout. I looked back just once, and I sure liked what I saw."

News cont.**HANDLE UP AS LAUREL WINTER MEET**

CONCLUDES Laurel Park boasted an increase in nearly every wagering category, including a 28.8 percent gain in total handle, for the 65-day Winter Meet which ended yesterday. The total handle was \$174,519,147, compared with \$134,474,545 for the same meet last year. Total Maryland live-card wagering was up 6.6 percent, from \$50,787,236 to \$54,123,806. The average daily on-track handle was \$1,890,761, up 9 percent from '94, but the greatest increase involved out-of-state betting on the Laurel cards, which swelled nearly 105 percent to \$43,761,504. Jockey Mark Johnston, an Eclipse winner in 1990, picked up his third Laurel riding title with 168 victories. King Leatherbury led the trainers for the 20th time, saddling 85 winners; he also had the most stakes wins with seven. (Jockey and trainer statistics are tabulated from September 27, 1994 through April 2, 1995).

JULY S. WINNER FALLOW INJURED

Fallow (Common Grounds), whose win in last year's GIII July S. at Newmarket earned him a top-20 place in Europe's International Classifications for juveniles, has sustained an injury which will keep him off the racecourse until at least autumn. The Sheikh Mohammed-owned colt, trained by David Loder, was being prepared for a 2000 Guineas bid. But he was pulled up during a routine work at Newmarket Saturday and later was found to have a pelvic fracture.
