SANTA ANITA DERBY WRAP-UP Santa Anita Derby hero Larry The Legend (Local Talent) came out of the race in good order and will make his next start in the Kentucky Derby, said owner/trainer Craig Lewis. "As hard as he ran, he came back good," he said Sunday. "He ran his eyeballs out--if he didn't, he wouldn't have gotten there." Runner-up Afternoon Deelites (Private Terms) is also doing well and will leave for Louisville "in about a week," according to trainer Richard Mandella. "We've got a month to work on that mile and a quarter," Mandella remarked vesterday. "I still don't think there's going to be a problem with that. He just used himself too many times (Saturday). We've got to make one run instead of three." The fast-closing Jumron (GB) (Sharpo {GB}), third in the three-horse photo, suffered a minor injury in the race but is still on schedule to ship to Churchill Saturday. "He grabbed his (right front) quarter a little bit, but it was just real minor," said his conditioner, Gary Lewis. "He's doing good this morning." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas will ship Timber Country (Woodman) and 15 others, including Tabasco Cat, east Tuesday. Lukas said Sunday that his colt was acting "like he could run again today." Both In Character (GB) (Never So Bold {GB}), sixth, and Petionville (Seeking the Gold), 7th, are also possible for the Kentucky Derby. "We scoped him and he came back fine," said trainer Randy Bradshaw of his colt, Petionville. "In retrospect, the race in Louisiana may have been a little tough on him. Right now, I don't know about the Derby. We'll train him for a week or two, see how he does and make a decision."

ANOTHER WORLD RECORD FOR TURF PARADISE Arizona-bred G Malleah (Fool the Experts) set a world record for six furlongs at Turf Paradise Saturday, taking the Grand Canyon H. by five lengths in 1:06 3/5. The four-year-old took a fifth of a second off the old mark while notching his first career stakes win; the previous record of 1:06 4/5 was held jointly by Zany Tactics, who ran it in the '87 Phoenix Gold Cup at Turf Paradise, and Honor The Hero, who tied the record in the '93 edition of the same race. G Malleah, second to Honor The Hero in this year's Phoenix Gold Cup, also holds the track record for six-and-a-half furlongs at the Arizona oval. News cont. p2
