ALL "TALK" IN THE WOOD In the most impressive Triple Crown prep of the season, overwhelming choice Talkin Man (With Approval) galloped into the role of Kentucky Derby favorite with a facile frontrunning victory in vesterday's Wood Memorial at Aqueduct. The glossy dark bay looked a picture in the paddock and a champion at the finish, cruising under the wire 7 3/4-lengths ahead of the overmatched field at 2-5. "I'm lost for words--it was so easy of a race it was pathetic," said winning jockey Shane Sellers. "If ever a race was over with three-quarters to go, it was this. This race won't take anything out of him; it was a stroll in the park." Sellers, who will relinquish the mount to Mike Smith for the Derby, added, "You've got to pay your dues...I'm thankful for this opportunity. I was hoping Thunder Gulch (Gulch) would run a big race in the Blue Grass and that maybe Mike would commit to him." Thunder Gulch, the victim of the larcenous Wild Syn (Wild Again), who stole the Blue Grass after setting a slow pace under jockey Randy Romero, finished fourth in his Derby prep. Roger Attfield, the trainer of three Canadian Triple Crown winners, will now send out Talkin Man in guest of his first American Triple Crown victory. "I couldn't be happier," he said after the Wood. "I think he did move up off the Gotham. He's had two races now--he's fresh and confident, and if he stays healthy, well ... " Well, he could become the first Derby favorite to wear the blanket of roses since Spectacular Bid 15 years ago.

# HORTON IS TOBA OWNER OF THE MONTH

Al J. Horton, owner of the Oaklawn H. runner-up and March 25 Razorback H. winner **Silver Goblin** (Silver Ghost), has been named TOBA owner of the month for March. The GII Razorback, which Silver Goblin won by 5½ lengths, marked the gelding's eighth consecutive victory and came on the heels of his seven-length win in the GIII Essex H. at Oaklawn Feb. 25. Horton owns a 51-acre Thoroughbred farm outside of McAlester, Oklahoma. Nominations for the April award are due in the TOBA office by Friday, April 29.

Wild Syn, the longest shot in the 6-horse field at 30-1, gained the lead soon after the start, drifted out slightly entering the first turn forcing Suave Prospect and THUNDER GULCH (Gulch) out in the process, controlled the pace through leisurely fractions of :24 1/5, :49, 1:13 1/5 and 1:37 2/5, then proved best. "We're definitely going (to the Kentucky Derby) if he comes out sound," said winning trainer Tom Arnemann. "He went a mile and an eighth real easy today, so I don't think a mile and a guarter will be a problem. And he doesn't have to be on the lead, he can be anywhere we want him." Suave Prospect, under Julie Krone, chased the winner in 2nd for most of the running but could not get to him. "Can you imagine beating Thunder Gulch and Tejano Run and not winning the Blue Grass?" asked Krone. "But he finished strong and you like to see that." Tejano Run, who trailed the field after 6 furlongs, gained ground late for the show spot. "We all had the same excuse," said Tejano Run's trainer Ken McPeek. "There was just no pace. We knew that, but I didn't think they would go quite that slow." Fountain of Youth and Florida Derby winner Thunder Gulch, going for his 3rd straight graded victory, pressed the pace early but came up empty in the stretch as the 6-5 bettors' choice. "I know some damn good horses that have run third or fourth in this race and come back and run good in the Derby," said Thunder Gulch's trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "We've already committed to run him, and we will run him. I have three dead fit horses (including Timber Country and Serena's Song) to run in the Derby and they all have the credentials, so I don't need to agonize now." Wild Syn, who paid \$62.40 to win, was the second longest-priced winner in Blue Grass history behind Dust Commander, who paid \$72.80 in 1970.
