Celtic Swing (GB) (Damister) maintained his unbeaten record with a workmanlike victory in vesterday's G3 Tripleprint Greenham S. at Newbury, England, winning eased up in a time just a halfsecond off the seven-furlong course record over the rain-softened ground. "Celtic Swing did it well and I'm sure he'll improve for the run," said owner Peter Savill. "But this is only the first step on a long road. Things will get a lot more difficult from now on." Willie Carson aboard runner-up Bahri, who had won only a modest race at Nottingham in four prior starts, thought his colt might have beaten the champ with a better trip. "If Bahri had settled, I think he might have won," said Carson. But winning jockey Kevin Darley disagreed. "My horse was only dossing once he took (the lead), and I think Willie will change his mind once he watches the race-recording." The two will meet again in the 2000 Guineas May 6; Celtic Swing is currently being held at even-money for that race.
