The Michael Stoute trainee had been a 10-1 shot for the Newmarket classic May 7, but was counted out of contention yesterday when a veterinary examination revealed a knee injury. Stoute, who will saddle Gay Gallanta (Woodman) for the Guineas, said he hopes to have Red Carnival racing again by the summer. This latest defection has led to the shortening of odds on other Guineas contenders. Harayir (Gulch), runner-up in the European Free Handicap, now heads the ante-post market at 7-2.

HORSEMEN'S CHOICE SALES RESULTS The first day of the Horsemen's Bloodstock inaugural Horsemen's Choice Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale, held April 22 in Ocala, Florida, saw a total of 32 hips sold for \$401,100, an average of \$12,534. The inquiry sign is flashing following the photo finish in the Arlington Heights' non-binding casino gambling referendum. The April 4 referendum was passed in favor of the casinos by a vote of 9,475 to 9,437, with approximately 42 percent of those eligible casting ballots. 
