SERENA'S SONG DEFINITE FOR DERBY

After weighing his options all week, trainer D. Wayne Lukas has decided to run Serena's Song (Rahy) against colts in next Saturday's Kentucky Derby. Lukas, leaning towards the Kentucky Oaks until the 11th hour, had gone as far as releasing jockey Corey Nakatani from his Derby commitment to the top filly before making a final decision yesterday. "They're only three once and the race that everyone wants to win is on May 6 at 5:35 p.m.," he said. "We're going to run her against the boys and give her that chance at immortality if we can. It took a lot of hard thought; I've been vascillating all week and talking with (owners) Bob and Beverly Lewis. Serena's Song is very good right now. You've got to feel she has a legitimate chance to win the race--and if you feel that in your heart, you've got to give her that chance." Lukas saddled distaff Derby winner Winning Colors in 1988; he will also send out Timber Country (Woodman) and Thunder Gulch (Gulch) for this year's "Run for the Roses."

KENTUCKY DERBY NOTES Santa Anita Derby runner-up Afternoon Deelites (Private Terms) had his final major Derby prep yesterday morning, going a mile in 1:42 over a fast Churchill strip. Said trainer Richard Mandella, "He was very relaxed. We weren't looking for anything fancy--just a nice, solid mile." The colt will blow out for the race at the end of the week. Blue Grass runner-up Suave Prospect (Fortunate Prospect), with jockey Julie Krone in the irons, worked an easy three-quarters in 1:17 2/5, going the first half in a pedestrian :53 before a final quarter in :24 2/5. "What we needed was the last quarter and we got it," said trainer Nick Zito. Tejano Run (Tejano), fourth in the Blue Grass, went a sharp seven furlongs in 1:24 3/5. Trainer Tony Reinstedler announced yesterday that his Derby prospect Knockadoon (Dixieland Band), runner-up in the Wood Memorial, will run for the roses; jockey Chris McCarron will ride. In Character (GB) (Never So Bold {GB}) worked six furlongs in 1:15 Saturday; trainer Bruce Jackson will need a jockey as Corey Nakatani is expected to ride Serena's Song. Jambalaya Jazz (Dixieland Band) worked five furlongs in 1:03 3/5. Flitch (Demons Begone) is now doubtful for the race.

Pat Day said that the colt had a hard time getting hold of the track. "He was struggling a little bit -- trying hard but going nowhere. In the middle of the turn, he settled a little and started getting a hold of the racetrack and then he went to picking up horses." The 6-5 favorite, MUHTAFAL (Mr. Prospector), a full-brother to Canadian Horse of the Year Afleet, came into the race a perfect two-for-two and took an early lead but tired in the final quarter. "He's not quite ready for this yet," said trainer Neil Drysdale. "He didn't have much chance to settle. Mr. Greeley was right on him. They just went very fast."

HOLLYWOOD OPENS WITH RECORDS

Hollywood Park set opening-day records of 50,715 in total attendance and \$9,756,407 in total handle Friday night when it kicked off its 56th spring/summer meet. The on-track attendance of 29,644 was the highest paid gate since 1984, before the advent of inter-track wagering. (Free admission drew 37,862 on-track fans for the '91 opener). Friday's on-track crowd more than doubled the '94 figure of 14,559 and even outdid the combined attendance of 27,151 for last year's opener, which was held on a Wednesday. On-track handle of \$3,600,275 was up 51.1 percent, while combined handle was up 48.8 percent over last year, when a then-opening day record \$6,558,806 was wagered. The former attendance record of 44,487 was set in 1947. California switched to the 'total' attendance system in 1987 with the advent of inter-track wagering.
