SKY BEAUTY SET FOR RETURN Last year's champion older mare Sky Beauty (Blushing Groom {Fr}), away since finishing well back in the Breeders' Cup Distaff, makes her return to action in Wednesday's GIII Vagrancy H. at Belmont. The five-year-old, winner in this race last year to start her '94 campaign, sports a perfect 11-for-11 record over the track. "I just don't know what happens in the Breeders' Cup," said her trainer, Allen Jerkens. "We can't seem to do anything right there." But Jerkens defended his Eclipse Award winner against those who say she can only win in New York. "They say she only wins at her home track. Where else is she supposed to run? She carried 130 pounds and 128 pounds last year. I don't know what more she can do."

DERBY BETTING IN ILLINOIS THREATENED

There will be a Kentucky Derby betting blackout in Illinois unless the latest dispute pitting the Chicago area's Balmoral Park and Maywood Park harness tracks against Churchill Downs is resolved. Churchill's involvement in the Merrillville, Indiana OTB parlor, which is 20 miles from Balmoral, has created an ongoing disagreement between Churchill and the harness tracks. Sportsman's Park received a letter Saturday from Alexander M. Waldrop, Churchill's Senior Vice President, Secretary and Counsel, advising that "all wagering on Churchill Downs' races in Illinois, including the Kentucky Derby, must cease immediately." Last year, Sportsman's and its inter-track network, which includes Balmoral and Maywood, handled \$3,126,506 on the Derby, 8.3 percent of the total off-track Derby handle. Illinois law requires a sending track make its program available to everyone on the network, which would keep Sportsman's from taking bets on the race if Churchill does not want Balmoral and Maywood to have access to the signal. NUMBERS UP AT AQUEDUCT On-track attendance and both on-track and total handle for the 85-day Aqueduct winter-spring meet, which ended yesterday, showed a marked increase over 1994 figures. The daily average attendance, 7,561, was up 10.5 percent over last year's average of 6,843. Ontrack handle, which included simulcasts from Florida and Kentucky, rose 14.7 percent with a daily average of \$2,209,991; the total daily average was \$6,043,703, an 18.1 percent increase over 1994. "The excellent winter weather has helped us reverse the trends of recent Aqueduct seasons," said Steven Crist, Executive Director of Communications and Development for the New York Racing Association. "In addition, the winter simulcasts at Gulfstream were strong. Our fans really seemed to respond to the alteration of the simulcast presentation."

DUCHOSSOIS SEEKS ST. LOUIS CASINO

Arlington International Racecourse owner Dick Duchossois not only wants a riverboat casino at his track, he also wants one on the Mississippi River off St. Louis. Duchossois and his son, Craig, are working with the Pitzker family of Chicago and the Levy brothers, Mark and Larry, of Chicago, in an attempt to win a license for a proposed \$80 million St. Louis riverboat. Paul O'Connor, Arlington's spokesman concerning casinos, said the St. Louis project has no connection with Duchossois' drive to obtain an Arlington casino if the Illinois legislature changes the law and allows more than the 10 boats presently licensed.

KENTUCKY DERBY NOTES

Talkin Man (With Approval) drilled six furlongs in 1:12 4/5 yesterday under jockey Mike Smith. "I asked him to pick it up at the top of the lane and he responded really well," said Smith. "And he came back dancing."

Probable favorite **Serena's Song** (Rahy), who will run coupled with **Timber Country** (Woodman) in the Derby, worked a strong six furlongs in 1:12 at Churchill yesterday. "She's got a great ability to handle the surface," said her trainer, D. Wayne Lukas. "She just skips over the top."

The addition of the filly to the Derby field has caused a problem for jockey Corey Nakatani, who had committed to ride In Character (GB) (Never So Bold {GB}) for trainer Bruce Jackson.

"The final update is that I talked to Mr. Jackson and informed him that we had to ride the filly," said Nakatani's agent, Bob Meldahl. "He wasn't too happy about that, and said I'd probably be talking to the stewards, so that's where it's at. I called the stewards (at Churchill) already and explained the situation to them...that I had a commitment from Jackson only if the filly didn't run. They asked me if it was in writing and I said, 'No, nothing's in writing'."

Jackson had been talking with jockeys Chris McCarron and Craig Perret, but both have now committed elsewhere; McCarron will ride **Knockadoon** (Dixieland Band) and Perret will ride **Jambalaya Jazz** (Dixieland Band), if he runs. That colt's trainer, John Ward, will make a final decision today.

Jockey Shane Sellers, who piloted Talkin Man to his Wood Memorial win, will ride longshot Lake George (Vice Regent) in the Derby; the colt is scheduled for a five-furlong work this morning.

Flitch (Demons Begone) will skip the Derby and point for the final jewel in the crown, the Belmont S.
