"THUNDER"STRUCK AT CHURCHILL

DOWNS D. Wayne Lukas became the most prolific Kentucky Derby trainer in history when he sent out three starters for yesterday's 121st "Run for the Roses," Lukas has now saddled a record 26 Derby starters, but the horse that was unsaddled in the Churchill winner's circle was not either half of the favored Team Lukas entry, Serena's Song (Rahy) or Timber Country (Woodman). The forgotten member of the Lukas Derby team, 24-1 Thunder Gulch (Gulch), a hero after his game victory in the Florida Derby but virtually ignored since a fourth-place finish in the Blue Grass, enjoyed a perfect trip just off speedy stablemate Serena's Song, powering to the lead at the top of the stretch and besting Tejano Run (Tejano) by 2 1/4 lengths to post the biggest upset since 30-1 Proud Clarion in 1967. "I've had a feeling for the last three days," said winning jockey Gary Stevens, who also piloted the Lukas-trained Winning Colors to Derby victory in 1988. "I can't explain it, but I felt so good about my chances (Friday) night...l got that gut feeling that everything was right." Added Lukas, "Thunder Gulch actually had a dream trip. Gary had him so wellplaced. He broke and he got into full stride and he never had to check. You could see at the five-eighths pole this little rascal was going to be tough--he was just rocking along. It was a great, great race for us, and I'm pleased with all three of our horses." Serena's Song tired from her early effort and finished 16th, but last year's champion two-year-old Timber Country was flying at the finish and missed giving Lukas a one-two punch by a head. The second choice in the race, Talkin Man (With Approval), loomed boldly at the top of the lane but had nothing left for the drive and faded to 12th. "I was just too fast too early," said his rider, Mike Smith. The top four finishers are all expected back for the Preakness.

Breaking from post 15 in the auxiliary starting gate, Stevens guided the Derby winner to good position just off the honest early fractions of SERENA'S SONG (Rahy). When the filly began to tire at the top of the stretch, TALKIN MAN (With Approval) made his move from the inside while Thunder Gulch came on threewide, but the Wood winner soon weakened while the hero of the Florida Derby finished strongly to earn the blanket of roses. Talkin Man faded badly in the stretch to finish 12th. Tejano Run, well back early, moved up steadily to reach contention at the top of the stretch and ran on well down the lane to take second by a head over the late-closing Timber Country. The latter lacked running room 'til they straightened for home but finished well when clear and just missed getting the place. JUMRON (GB) (Sharpo {GB}), third choice, also showed a decent kick but weakened late to be fourth. AFTERNOON DEELITES (Private Terms) tried to savage Jumron after the two brushed the first time through the stretch and ran evenly throughout the race.

"Thierry (Jarnet) told me Pennekamp won the race in four strides," said Fabre. "He also said he thought the horse idled a little when in front. They went no pace early and he had to come a bit early. This is a very quiet, settled horse--ideal for the Derby at Epsom." Celtic Swing, who may have found the ground too hard for his liking, will also now point for the Epsom Derby. "He goes straight to Epsom now and goes with a great chance," said his owner. Peter Savill. "Naturally, I would have been happier to have won. But it was a privilege to have been part of such a great race. We can't be confident of reversing placings with Pennekamp, but we are hopeful."
