KENTUCKY DERBY WRAP-UP Derby winner Thunder Gulch (Gulch) and his stablemate, third-place finisher Timber Country (Woodman), both came out of yesterday's "Run for the Roses" in good order and will ship to Pimlico Wednesday to get ready for the Preakness. Pacesetter Serena's Song (Rahy) (16th) will be given a little break before getting ready for a summer and fall campaign. Tejano Run (Tejano) was tired after his second-place effort. "He didn't show much sign of life and he didn't eat up," said Mike Porter, assistant to trainer Ken McPeek. "The horse is walking fine...if he goes back to eating in a couple days like he was before the Derby, the Preakness would be likely." Said McPeek, "I want to point to the Belmont, and if I feel running in the Preakness would compromise the Belmont, we'll skip the Preakness. It just depends on what he tells us the next few days." Jumron (GB) (Sharpo {GB}), fourth in the Derby, came out of the race somewhat the worse for the wear and is now likely to miss the Preakness. "He grabbed his (left front) guarter and hit himself in a couple of spots. The quarter he grabbed was a lot deeper than I thought," said trainer Gary Lewis. "He'll leave for California Tuesday." Lewis said the Swaps S. at Hollywood would probably be next for the colt. Probable for the Preakness are Eltish (Cox's Ridge) (6th), Talkin Man (With Approval) (12th) and Ski Captain (Storm Bird) (14th); Citadeed (Shadeed) (9th) is also a possible. Mecke (Maudlin) (5th) will point for either the Preakness, the Jersey Derby (May 27) or the Ohio Derby (June 17). Knockadoon (Dixieland Band) (7th) and Dazzling Falls (Taylor's Falls) (13th) will skip the Preakness but could return to the Triple Crown trail for the Belmont. Afternoon Deelites (Private Terms) (8th) was scoped after the race and found to have pharyngitis; the Preakness has not been ruled out.

CIGAR EARNS TOP WEIGHT FOR PIMLICO

SPECIAL Allen Paulson's Cigar (Palace Music) will shoulder high weight of 122 pounds when he bids for his seventh straight victory in next Saturday's GI Pimlico Special. The five-year-old carried 121 to victory in the GI Oaklawn H. last out; Concern (Broad Brush), highweight at 122 when third in that race, has been assigned 121 for Pimlico.

The top three are expected to point for the Epsom Oaks; most bookmakers have the top two as 4-1 joint favourites, with Moonshell at 5-1.

CELTIC SWING OUT OF EPSOM DERBY? Celtic Swing (GB) (Damister), who suffered his first career loss when second in Saturday's 2000 Guineas, may skip a rematch with Guineas winner Pennekamp (Bering (GB) and point for the French Derby instead. "I still very much want to take on Pennekamp again, but feel the hill at Epsom is not going to be ideal for my horse." said owner Peter Savill. "I think that if the ground was soft or on the easy side of good, we wouldn't be too worried and would go to the Derby. But if it looked like being firm, we might have to think of other possibilities. The French Derby would obviously be an alternative, followed by the Irish Derby." Most bookmakers have removed Celtic Swing from their Epsom Derby lists and now quote Pennekamp at around even-money for the race. Munwar (Kalaglow {Ire}), due to run in Saturday's Classic Trial at Lingfield, is on offer at 7-1 while Presenting (Mtoto {GB}), an impressive winner at Newmarket Friday, is an 8-1 chance.

RECORD HANDLE AT GOLDEN GATE A busy Kentucky Derby Day at Golden Gate Fields resulted in a record Northern California handle of \$7,093,420.80. Golden Gate offered nine live races, full-card simulcasting from Woodbine, Hollywood and Hong Kong's Sha Tin Racecourse, and six races from Churchill Downs. The handle easily topped the previous high in Northern California, \$6,685,040, which was set on Kentucky Derby Day, 1990.

FORTY NINER DAYS RETIRED Forty Niner Days (Conquistador Cielo), Northern California's Horse of the Year in 1991 and a career earner of \$1,009,625, has been retired. The eight-year-old gelding made his last start Wednesday at Golden Gate and checked in last in the 1 1/16-mile test for \$25,000 claimers. "He's run too many races and just doesn't have it any more." said his trainer, Roger Stein. "The horse has made \$1 million and there's no sense in cheapening him up anymore than we already have." The grey was vanned to Rancho Del Charro in Pleasanton, California last Thursday. Said jockey Ron Warren Jr., aboard for the millionaire's last race, "He's still sound and he travels good--he just doesn't care about racing any more. When it came time to pick it up, he just kept going at the same pace. It was like he said, 'forget it, this is too much work'."

BREEDERS' CUP BILL STALLED IN FLORIDA The chances of the Breeders' Cup returning to South Florida in the near future are growing dim. The Florida legislative session ended Friday, May 5, and Representative Steve Geller (D-Hallandale) took steps to ensure that the Breeders' Cup bill would not get out of the House. The Senate version of the bill, which includes an amendment to rotate the prime winter dates between Hialeah and Gulfstream, passed by a vote of 36-1. Geller claims he had to kill the House bill before the dates amendment, added by Senator Roberto Casas (R-Hialeah), was attached. "I've said all along that the Hialeah amendment would kill the bill. Now we have demonstrated that's the case," said Geller. There is a slim chance that Governor Lawton Chiles will add the Breeders' Cup bill to a short list of budget matters that legislators have to clean up in Tallahassee next month. A full-card simulcasting bill and a bill to allow card rooms at parimutuel sites also met with opposition and failed to get to the floor for a vote. This is the second year in a row the Florida legislators have failed to pass any significant parimutuel laws because of in-fighting among the differing factions. News cont. p3

HIALEAH SIMULCASTING THREATENED The Florida Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association will meet with Hialeah officials today to discuss the track's purse distribution, which has averaged \$4,000 a day below the level set by contract for the first 42 days of the current meet. FHBPA President Kent Sterling said yesterday that if Hialeah does not agree to increase purses to meet contractual demands, horsemen will "pull the plug" on the track's simulcasting. Meanwhile, citing an increase in simulcasting revenue which has boosted the total handle 15 percent, Hialeah announced an unspecified purse increase yesterday. Effective Tuesday, the raise is hinged to another clause in the contract and is unrelated to the ongoing dispute.
