KENTUCKY REFUSES HIALEAH SIGNAL

Hialeah continues to send out its simulcast signal despite the objections of the Florida Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association, and while most simulcast outlets, including Las Vegas, Pimlico and Suffolk Downs, continue to take Florida racing, Kentucky has refused the signal. "We went through problems with Turfway in 1978 regarding the Interstate Horse Racing Act and we know the ramifications," said Alex Waldrap, Senior Vice President and General Counsel for Churchill Downs, the current hub of Kentucky's simulcasting network. "Any track that proceeds to take Hialeah, proceeds at their own peril." Hialeah received permission to send its signal out of state through a contract with the newly formed Florida Owner's Horsemen's Association, which claims to have 20 members and is headed by trainer William Wright. Ed Towey, a spokesman for the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulations which oversees the Division of Parimutue! Wagering, said the state would not intervene. "This is a dispute between two private parties and at this point, we don't intend to inject ourselves into it," he said.

BOB ERWIN DEAD Bob Erwin, a Texas owner and breeder of both quarter horse and Thoroughbred racehorses, died Thursday morning at his home in Dallas after suffering an aneurysm. He was 62. Erwin, an insurance executive, was one of the nation's leading breeders of miniature horses before becoming involved in the racing industry; he was fourth-leading quarter horse owner nationally last year, and also held an interest in Centennial Farm's MGISW Colonial Affair.

On an uncontested lead through moderate fractions, 2-5 favorite Cigar was never challenged, opening up by five at the top of the stretch and coasting home under a Jerry Bailey hand ride. "I don't have to do a whole lot of work on this horse," said Bailey. "Bill Mott does it all. I just get on board." Added the winning trainer, "It looked on paper to be pretty void of speed, other than us, and that's the way it worked out. Maybe on this day we had a little bit of an unfair advantage." As for the future, Mott said, "Our plan, number one, is the big race at the end of the year--the Breeders' Cup Classic. We'll work backwards with that in view. The Mass 'Cap is a definite possibility. Because of that bonus he is eligible for, it could mean more than \$600,000 for him." Devil His Due shadowed the winner from the start, dropped back as they straightened for home, but came on again when joined by the late-running Concern and proved clearly second best. "I thought he ran great; he was running good at the end," said assistant trainer Jimmy Jerkens. "It looks like he wants to go a little further, now that he is older. He wants to relax early." The six-year-old will point for the Suburban H. at Belmont July 4, as will Concern. Said his trainer, Richard Small, "To beat Cigar, there will have to be a horse to really run with him. My horse ran his race. Maybe when we meet (Cigar) again there will be something to run with him. I'm thinking about the Suburban next; we'll space out his races. It's a long season." The two fought it out to the wire, with Munwar prevailing in the photo; the victory, however, did not impress the bookmakers, who quote him at 10-1 for the Epsom Derby. "The question is, how good is today's second," said Munwar's trainer, Peter Walwyn. "Munwar had to make his own running, which didn't suit him. (Stablemate) Daffaq will do that in the Derby. Besides, the horse still needs some sun on his back. He hates the cold—we've had him under sunlamps all winter—and he still hasn't come in his coat."
