HARAYIR BOUND FOR IRELAND Harayir (Gulch), who gave her sire his second Classic win of the weekend when taking the English 1000 Guineas May 7, will make her next start in Ireland. Said owner Hamdan al Maktoum's racing manager, Anthony Stroud, "She will go for the Irish 1000 Guineas in two weeks time and then, most likely, for the Coronation S. at Royal Ascot."

JUMRON OFF TRIPLE CROWN TRAIL Jumron (GB) (Sharpo {GB}), fourth in the Kentucky Derby, will skip the final two legs of the Triple Crown and return to California to get ready for the Swaps S. at Hollywood Park July 23. "The horse, he talked to us," said trainer Gary Lewis. "He pulled a little muscle behind (Saturday). It's not serious. The owner and I talked about it; we had said if he was not 100 percent, he would not run. He would be 90 to 95 percent, and that's not good enough. He'll probably miss about 10 days of serious training, but shouldn't lose a lot of conditioning. He'll stay (at Pimlico) until next week, when we can get a flight back to California."
