## MISTER BAILEYS TO VINERY Mister Baileys (Robellino), who won last year's English 2,000 Guineas in course-record time, will begin his stud career in 1996 at Vinery in Midway, Kentucky. "Mister Baileys overwhelmed me with his physical and mental quality which combine to give him a special charisma," said Vinery owner Ben Walden Jr., who traveled to England's National Stud to inspect, and purchase, the four-year-old colt. "This talented miler is the perfect horse to be Vinery's first import from Europe." The winner of the G2 Royal Lodge and G3 Champagne S. at two, Mister Baileys was unable to stand the 1995 season due to grass sickness. "(He) is 75 percent through the recovery phase," said veterinarian Nick Mills. "By late summer he should be back to normal health."

PASEANA RETURNS NEXT SUNDAY Champion Paseana (Arg) (Ahmad {Arg}), third in the GI Apple Blossom last time out April 21, will make her next start in the \$100,000a Hawthorne H. at Hollywood May 28, trainer Ron McAnally confirmed Thursday. The eight-year-old mare, with career earnings of \$3,070,403, is \$193,433 shy of the all-time North American distaff money title, currently held by Dance Smartly.

As for his runners, Lukas remains high on last year's top two-year-old. "If he gets an opportunity to see daylight, you'll see the real Timber Country (Woodman)," he said of the colt, who ran a troubled third in the Derby. "He's getting sharper. If he gets a chance to run, he'll be tough."

#### PEAKS AND VALLEYS POSSIBLE FOR BELMONT

Illinois Derby winner Peaks And Valleys (Mt. Livermore) is a "real possibility" to join the field for the Belmont S. June 10, according to his trainer, Jimmy Day. "He came out of the race very well," said Day, adding that the colt will be based in Toronto until his next start. "If we run in the Belmont, he'll ship in a day or two before the race."
