PREAKNESS REDEMPTION FOR TIMBER

COUNTRY Trainer D. Wayne Lukas never lost the faith but after four straight losses, he told jockey Pat Day that for last year's champion two-year-old Timber Country (Woodman), it was "time to fish or cut bait." Day promptly took out his rod and reel and hooked a Classic for his mount's most ardent supporter. With a gritty half-length win in yesterday's Preakness S. at Pimlico, Timber Country lived up to his trainer's billing and earned Lukas his fourth straight Classic win, tying the record set by Lucien Laurin in 1973. "This should put to rest a lot of the criticism of Timber Country as last year's two-year-old champion," said Lukas, "I told Pat today, 'you've got to be the driver, not the passenger.' When this horse gets his stride and gets a chance to run in the clear down the lane, he runs." His jockey had noticed a difference in this colt all week. "I worked him last Monday morning and he came back bouncing and he's not done that all spring," said Day. As Lukas explained, "What we did is try to sharpen him up a little bit and get the late kick through the stretch a little sharper." He said he expected to send both Timber Country and Thunder Gulch (Gulch) on to the June 10 Belmont S. "I think the Belmont will be a helluva race." he said. "These are good horses; I'm excited about turning them loose in the Belmont. Maybe we'll win a Triple Crown, even if we have to relay it."

KENTUCKY DERBY TV RATING DROPS Television ratings for ABC's broadcast of the 121st Kentucky Derby, May 6, were down 20 percent from 1994. The national rating for this year's telecast was 6.0 with a 20 percent share, as compared to 7.5 with a 21 percent share last year. Each rating point represents 954,000 TV households; shares are the percentage of sets in use. The 1995 figures are the lowest in 12 years.

Settled in sixth through three-quarters, the Eclipse winner kicked it into gear on the far turn, catching the leaders at the eighth pole while rallying on the far outside and edging longshot Oliver's Twist to give jockey Pat Day his second straight Preakness win. Said Day, "He broke somewhat sharper than he has--Wayne's training has sharpened him up. He was a whole lot more responsive, competitive and enthusiastic about his work today." Oliver's Twist, local hero of the Federico Tesio S., was just off the pace early, lacked running room at the top of the stretch, but finished with determination once clear to outgame Derby winner Thunder Gulch for the place. Second choice TALKIN MAN (With Approval) once again loomed boldly at the top of the stretch but faded in the drive and finished sixth. Both TEJANO RUN (Tejano) and PANA BRASS (Dixieland Band) bled. "After he was scoped, it showed he has a slight lung infection," said trainer Ken McPeek of Tejano Run, who battled just such an infection earlier this year. "But you'll see him again this fall--maybe even late summer."
