PREAKNESS WRAP-UP Team Lukas runners Timber Country (Woodman), first in the Preakness, and Thunder Gulch (Gulch), third, who reversed finishing places from the Derby, both came out of the second leg of the Triple Crown in excellent condition and will start next in the Belmont S. "There's not a hair out of place on either one of them," said D. Wayne Lukas. The colts will return to Churchill Downs today, and ship to Belmont the Tuesday before the race. Lukas added that future plans include an East Coast campaign for Timber Country, while Thunder Gulch will race out west. If one of the two wins the Belmont, Lukas will become the first trainer to sweep the Triple Crown races with more than one horse. Runner-up Oliver's Twist (Horatius) is likely to skip the Belmont and point instead for the Ohio Derby June 17. Trainer Nick Zito may send out a pair for the Belmont; Star Standard (Risen Star) (4th) is a definite for the race, while Suave Prospect (Fortunate Prospect) could return to the Triple Crown trail in New York: after disappointing in the Derby, the latter will make his next start in the Peter Pan S. Mecke (Maudlin), fifth in both the Derby and Preakness, bled Saturday and will return to Florida for a rest. "I think we'll probably turn him out at my farm in Ocala for a while," said trainer Manny Tortora. Talkin Man (With Approval) (6th) also bled. "Obviously, the Belmont is out," said his trainer, Roger Attfield. "I'll have to give a little thought to plans for his future, but very likely I'll bring him up to Woodbine soon." Our Gatsby (Strike Gold) (7th) came out of the race with a chip in his left ankle which will require surgery. "It's not a big problem, but he'll be off for at least three months," said trainer Donnie Von Hemel.

TAKING RISKS INJURED Taking Risks (Two Punch), winner of last year's GI Iselin H., went off the 2-5 favorite in yesterday's William Donald Schaeffer H. at Pimlico but pulled up lame and will have to be retired from racing. "Taking Risks suffered broken sesamoids in the left front ankle," said Dr. Dan Dreyfus. "Currently, the injury does not appear to be life-threatening. However, these injuries tend to change, so we will continue to monitor him on a day-to-day basis. There is no apparent damage to the blood supply or the nerves in the foot. His career as a race horse is over."

"He took a while to come to hand this year and was very fresh when making his reappearance at Sandown," said trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam of his '95 winner. "But he's been working well since and has come on a lot since that first run. The Derby is now the plan and he'll stay a mile and a half all right." Chapple-Hyam also saddled Irish 2000 winners Rodrigo de Triano ('92) and Turtle Island ('94). Bahri, the hot favorite who was also third in the English 2000 Guineas, was not helped by the fact that he spread a plate at the start and had to be re-shod. Undefeated in three starts, Spectrum is now quoted third choice at 5-1 for the Epsom Derby; Pennekamp (Bering {GB}) is currently favored for the race at 11-8, while Celtic Swing (Damister) is being held at 5-2.

#### SERENA'S SONG POSSIBLE FOR MOTHER

GOOSE Serena's Song (Rahy) came back from her easy victory in Friday's Black-Eyed Susan in good shape, and could remain East to run in the second leg of New York's Triple Tiara, the Mother Goose June 9. "She looks good," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "This may be a chance to take advantage of this eastern swing. Then I'll take her and Thunder Gulch west."

WORLD RECORD AT HOLLYWOOD Lucky Forever (Lucky North), winner of Saturday's Rich Cream S. at Hollywood, set a world record for six-and-a-half furlongs in the race, going the distance in 1:13 1/5 over the fast main track. The six-year-old gelding had returned from a 15-month layoff in March; he picked up his first win since 1993 by five lengths.

PREAKNESS SETS ATTENDANCE, HANDLE RECORDS A record in-state crowd of 100,818 was in attendance at Maryland betting sites for Saturday's Preakness at Pimlico; the figure includes 87,707, second highest attendance in track history, at Pimlico, as well as totals from Laurel, Rosecroft and Delmarva. The total handle of \$15,910,405 was a single-day wagering record for the track; the previous mark of \$12,917,130 was set on last year's Preakness card.
