NO DOUBLE FOR HARAYIR Ridgewood Pearl (GB) (Indian Ridge {GB}) sank Harayir's (Gulch) bid to become the first filly to complete an English/Irish 1000 Guineas double at the wet and windy Curragh racecourse vesterday. A seven-length winner of the listed Athasi S. on her only previous appearance this year, the winner moved up to challenge stablemate Khaytada (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}), third, and favoured Haravir three furlongs from the line, and went on to win easily from the strong-finishing Warning Shadows (Ire) (Cadeaux Genereux (GB)). "Certainly the Coronation S. (at Royal Ascot) would be an obvious target for her," said trainer John Oxx, winning his first Irish 1000. "A mile is her distance. She would not want the ground too firm, but good would be all right and she obviously handles conditions as they were here." The conditions may have played a part in Harayir's defeat; the filly, looking a good deal lighter than on her earlier Classic appointment, was a well-beaten fifth, and her connections said the ground did not suit her at all. She will start in the Coronation S. "only if the going is right," said trainer Major Dick Hern. (Irish 1000 Guineas chart p5).

### MONMOUTH PARK LAUNCHES 50TH SEASON

Monmouth Park opens for its 50th anniversary season today with the first of 20 stakes, the \$35,000 John J. Reilly H. Opening day will also feature the inductions of Holy Bull and Dehere into the Monmouth Hall of Champions. The 1995 Monmouth Summer Meet will run through Sunday, September 3 with live racing every day but Mondays and Thursdays; first post is 1:00 p.m. The track will also offer full-card simulcasting for the first time during its live racing season, with a menu from New York, Philadelphia, Maryland, Arlington and/or Calder seven days a week. Monmouth will host a live card Monday, May 29, for a special Memorial Day program, with no live racing Wednesday, May 31.
