CITADEED HOOKS BELMONT BERTH WITH PETER PAN VICTORY Citadeed (Shadeed), ninth in the Kentucky Derby in his U.S. debut and his first start beyond seven furlongs, vesterday earned his way back onto the Triple Crown trail with a half-length win in the Gll Peter Pan S. at Belmont. Well backed at 6-1, the Kentucky-bred bay broke sharply, dropped back to fifth, then came running down the lane to edge past Pat N Jac (Pentelicus) under jockey Eddie Maple. "He scared me at first when he backed out on Eddie--he dropped back real sharp," said trainer Rick Violette Jr., who took over the colt's conditioning following the Derby. "I wasn't sure if he wanted to run today, but he proved me wrong. I think the fast pace really helped with the outcome." As for the Belmont S., Violette said, "We'll talk it over with the owners and make it definite." The runner-up won't try the mile and a half of the "Test of the Champion," but Treasurer (GB) (Darshaan), another neck back in third, could wheel back in the third leg of the Crown. Said trainer Kiaran McLaughlin, "The only thing is if we ran in the Belmont he would have run three times in a month and that's a lot for any horse. He is a big, strong horse; if he bounces back good after this race, I'd have to say he's a strong possibility." Suave Prospect (Fortunate Prospect), the crowd's 4-5 choice, made a move around the far turn but hung in the drive to finish fifth; trainer Nick Zito said after the race that his colt had bled. "Pat Day said he was moving up but that he never kicked in--now we know why," said Zito. "If this was a Lasix state, he might have won. There's no getting around it--he needs Lasix."

SOUL OF THE MATTER BACK ON TRACK Soul Of The Matter (Private Terms), sidelined with foot problems since finishing fourth in the '94 Breeders' Cup Classic, worked a half-mile in :51 3/5 on the Hollywood main track yesterday and is likely to run before the meet ends July 24. "He might race here before we leave," said trainer Richard Mandella. "He's doing real well. I just gave him a long rest and he's doing great."
