BELMONT STAKES NOTES Blue Grass winner Wild Syn (Wild Again), who pressed the pace but faded to last in the Kentucky Derby, will make his next start in the Belmont S. June 10. "We did beat the Derby winner (in the Blue Grass), you know," said Kenny Martin, assistant to trainer Tom Arnemann. The colt is scheduled for a seven-furlong breeze Wednesday; Randy Romero will again have the call in the Belmont. The Team Lukas duo of Derby winner Thunder Gulch (Gulch) and Preakness winner Timber Country (Woodman) worked Monday at Churchill Downs. Thunder Gulch went a half in :49 with Donna Barton in the irons while his stablemate went five-eighths in 1:00, also with Barton aboard. The two will be joined by Wild Syn on a flight for New York June 6.

SIMULCAST CHANGES AT NYRA Beginning Wednesday, the New York Racing Association will stop simulcasting its full cards to the Meadowlands after Catskill OTB, New York City OTB and Yonkers Raceway voiced their objections to the program. Full-card simulcasting to the Meadowlands and Monmouth had begun May 10, but, according to NYRA Director of Communications and Development Steve Crist, NYRA elected to drop the simulcasts "for the sake of harmony." The Meadowlands is approximately 20 miles from Aqueduct and Belmont across the Hudson River in New Jersey. NYRA will continue to simulcast its full cards to Monmouth Park. According to Crist, however, NYRA may soon be the full-time receiver of full cards from the New Jersey tracks and others. Crist said that the New York State Assembly and State Senate were filing a joint bill which would allow both NYRA and OTB to simulcast one additional track every day. Crist said the bill was expected to be passed within a week, but will not take effect until the fall. NYRA currently can only take full cards during the winter. Crist said he was unsure of what track NYRA would take, but that the likely summer signal next year would be Monmouth. "OTB very much wants to simulcast several (fullcards)," said Crist. "This is something they want a lot more than we do, but we feel we can handle a second signal. It worked well this year with Gulfstream and we can put it in an area of the track where it won't bother the people who like the current format of 30 minutes between races." Crist said that under no circumstances would additional simulcasts be taken at Saratoga.

I asked my horse to run in the stretch and he responded real strong." The 7-5 favorite, SILVER GOBLIN (Silver Ghost), raced just off the pace for five furlongs before tiring to finish last. Said rider Dale Cordova, "He had a clean trip and he left the gate nice. The surface may have been too heavy because he is a much better horse than this."
