CELTIC SWING DEFINITE FOR PRIX DU

JOCKEY-CLUB Celtic Swing (GB) (Damister) will miss next week's Derby at Epsom; Europe's champion juvenile of 1994, who was beaten for the first time by **Pennekamp** (Bering {GB}) in last month's 2000 Guineas, has been supplemented instead for Sunday's Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly. Speculation over Celtic Swing's participation in Britain's premier Classic has been intense since his narrow defeat at Newmarket, with some newspapers going so far as to employ astrologers in attempts to predict whether owner Peter Savill would allow the colt to run. But, at a press conference Thursday in London, Savill gave the thumbs down to a Derby bid, saying, "My heart told me Epsom, but my head says France. The horse will run at Chantilly, and the choice has been made solely in the interests of Celtic Swing himself." Savill's decision, which he described as "one of the most heart-wrenching of my life," was reached after he had investigated ground conditions at Epsom. Celtic Swing is known to prefer give underfoot--fast going at Newmarket was used to explain his Guineas loss--and recent heavy rain in the south of England has apparently bypassed Epsom. DANCING BRAVE'S STUD CAREER THREATENED

Dancing Brave (Lyphard), whose early stud career in Britain was limited by an attack of Marie's Disease, or pulmonary osteoarthropathy, has been forced to stop covering mares at his new base in Japan. The 1986 Arc winner had been due to cover 65 mares at the Japan Racing Association's Hokkaido Stud this year. But, owing to an unspecified illness, he was allowed only 35 visits this season. It is not yet known if this latest setback is related to the attack of Marie's Disease, a very rare disease which begins in the chest cavity and progresses to the bones, which hit Dancing Brave at Newmarket's Dalham Hall in 1987. A spokesman for the JRA said only, "Dancing Brave has been unwell. He stopped covering mares at the end of April. We hope he will be able to cover mares again next season. We are taking the view that a lot of rest and recuperation is needed."

Saturday, Belmont

\$100,000a Genuine Risk S.-GII, f/m, 6f
Classy Mirage (Storm Bird) will carry 122 pounds, just one higher than the Shug McGaughey-trained **Recognizable** (Seattle Slew), who comes off a puzzling last-place finish as the 1-5 favorite in Aqueduct's Bed o' Roses. "It's mystifying," said Buzzy Tenney, McGaughey's assistant, "but she hasn't missed any training since and she's been on a routine work schedule. She's doing real good right now, but that Classy Mirage is a tough mare and you'd better be ready any time you line up against Mr. Jerkens." The Allen Jerkens-trained 5-year-old mare made her '95 debut May 13 at Belmont with a six-furlong allowance win by nine lengths in 1:09.71. "She was in with lesser company than she'll be in with Saturday," said Jerkens, "but she's doing like she does when she's at her best." The win was particularly comforting for her trainer after losses in the 9-furlong Beldame and and 7-furlong First Flight at the end of last year. "She just went bad--that's all," said Jerkens. "She started breaking out in hives all over. She's done that before, and all the vets I have can't figure out why."

Saturday, Suffolk Downs

\$500,000 Massachusetts H., 3yo/up, 9f
Kandaly (Alydar) blew out three furlongs yesterday morning at Suffolk. "He went smoothly and it looks like this is a similar track to Philadelphia where he ran a good third in the Pennsylvania Derby," said Robert Kelly, who will be listed as the trainer of record Saturday, with Louie Roussel named as co-owner. Howie Teshler, trainer of **Bull in the Heather** (Ferdinand), who was assigned 108 lbs after recently winning his first race since his '93 Florida Derby triumph, joked about the weights. "They put too much weight on my horse," said Teshler. "I had a 90-lb. rider lined up from the circus. After Cigar, the race is very competitive. My horse took a long time to win again and I don't want to hurt his confidence, but I think he'll win with the right spot."

OFF'N'AWAY TO BELMONT Irish invader **Off'N'Away** (Be My Guest), a full brother to 1990 Belmont S. winner **Go And Go** owned by Moyglare Stud, will be shipped from trainer Dermot Weld's Irish base to contest the third leg of the Triple Crown June 10. **Off'N'Away** will be making just his fifth lifetime start in the Belmont. One-for-two as a two-year-old, he was third in the Kentucky Derby Trial on the all-weather track at Lingfield earlier this year. His most recent start was a win in an allowance May 1 at Navan. In other Belmont news, the connections of **Petionville** (Seeking The Gold), are now considering a start in the race, while those of **Peaks and Valleys** (Mt. Livermore) have decided against running.

KEENELAND APPLIES FOR SUMMER MEET

Keeneland officials requested dates for a 15-day summer meeting from the Kentucky Racing Commission when it applied for its traditional spring and fall race dates for 1996 yesterday. While the track applied for the July 5 to July 28 meet, Keeneland president Bill Greely raised concerns about the viability of summer racing at this time. In his letter to the commission, Greely said that Keeneland would anticipate a maximum average attendance of 8,000 per day and \$200,000 per day in purses. Summer racing at Keeneland could put it in direct competition with Ellis Park near Henderson, Ky. "Given Ellis Park's current purse distribution and the number of horses available for racing in Kentucky, Keeneland believes the thoroughbred industry is best served by awarding summer racing days in 1996 similar to the 1995 racing dates," said Greely. "Consistent with our position of last year, if summer Thoroughbred dates are awarded in Fayette County, they should be held at Keeneland. We also believe that Ellis Park is an important segment of the Kentucky racing circuit and should remain so."

SALMAN STUD FOR SALE Ballyfeighan Stud, a 500-acre estate in Ireland's County Kildare owned by Fahd Salman, is to be sold at auction. The sale, expected to be announced this weekend, is part of the general cutback in the Saudi Arabian's racing interests. Salman has already revealed that he is to sell mares and yearlings in both Britain and the U.S. this autumn, but the sale of the stud does not appear to indicate Salman is getting out of the sport completely. "He is not pulling out of racing--merely pruning the number of horses," said racing manager Anthony Penfold. "We shall still keep some mares in England, Ireland and America."
