### CIGAR ROLLS TO VICTORY IN MASS

**'CAP** Despite a \$650,000 payday, a seven-race winning streak on the line and the pressure of trying to become the shortest-priced favorite ever to win a race that has been historically tough on chalk, there was remarkably little stress in the air at Suffolk Downs yesterday. Still, in the aftermath of **Cigar's** (Palace Music) four-length win in the Massachusetts H.--and in the spirit of good sportsmanship--his connections tried. "Well, naturally, walking in the starting gate you wonder if they're going to stumble..." said trainer Bill Mott. Jockey Jerry Bailey stopped worrying much earlier. When did he think he had it won? "You hate to say something silly like 'when the overnight came out'..." he said. It was that easy. Rating three-wide off the early pace, Cigar gradually gained ground on the far turn, took the lead at will and drew away from five clearly overmatched rivals; in winning his eighth race in a row and picking up an additional \$500,000 bonus for sweeping the Gulfstream Park H., Oaklawn H., Pimlico Special and Mass 'Cap, he earned superlatives from everyone involved. "Best horse I've ever ridden, and I've ridden some good ones," said Bailey. "If he can hold his form--which is difficult to do from the beginning of the year through the Breeders' Cup--there's not anybody who can really beat him." Said Mott, "He has blown his fields away. I try to be objective about him, but it's like watching my kids play soccer, and hoping they're pretty good." Mott said he will now give Cigar some time off, indicating the five-year-old's next start would be either the August 5 Whitney or the August 20 Iselin H. "You won't see him in the entry box for at least 60 days," said Mott. "He's earned a little vacation to Bermuda." The final numbers have not been totalled, but Suffolk Downs is estimating a single-day record handle of better than \$4 million for the '95 Mass 'Cap card; an exact figure will be announced after all simulcast outlets have reported their handle.

**NEW YORK PASSES RACING BILL** Racing legislation which changes takeout rates, expands out-of-state simulcasting to New York tracks and lowers the New York Racing Association's parimutuel tax was passed in Albany Friday night and is expected to be signed into law by Governor George Pataki within days. The bill, which takes effect July 21, lowers New York's takeout from 17 to 15 percent on straight wagers while raising the takeout on multiple wagers from 17 to 20 percent. The extra revenue will be shared by NYRA, the OTB's and the horsemen; purses are expected to increase by more than \$8 million annually. The legislation will also reduce NYRA's parimutuel tax from 4 to 3 percent on straight wagers and from 4 to 2.5 percent on multiple wagers, providing the organization with a projected \$7 million a year. Beginning September 1, Belmont will offer one full-card simulcast from out of state daily; in-home simulcasting has been extended for another year.

**FULL-CARD SIMULCASTING AT CALDER** Calder President Ken Dunn said yesterday that full-card simulcasting at Calder will be offered on an experimental basis from June 25 through July 9. Calder will also experiment with net pool pricing on those cards, adding the percentage fee that is charged by the sending track into the takeout of the receiving track. The takeout on the regular Calder program will not change. Calder can only present full-card simulcasting for a limited time due to current state law. "If the results are positive, it will be our intention to seek approval from the state to continue with full-card simulcasting," said Dunn. The Florida HBPA is supporting the experiment.
