CIGAR TO RACE AT SIX? Cigar (Palace Music), an easy winner of Saturday's Massachusetts H. at Suffolk, will make three more starts this year as he continues his quest to finish his 1995 season unbeaten. Beyond that, there are no definite plans, but trainer Bill Mott yesterday indicated that Cigar is likely to run next year as a six-year-old. "Naturally, we'll first see how he ends up this year, but if he is healthy and finishes up the season well, I think Mr. Paulson will consider it. He likes to see this horse run. He is having a lot of fun with it. I know, however, that it will be hard to duplicate what he's done this year."

CONCERN TO CALIFORNIAN Trainer Richard Small confirmed that Breeders' Cup Classic winner **Concern** (Broad Brush) would be shipped to California to run in Sunday's GI Californian at Hollywood. "If all goes well, we'll ship him to Monmouth Park and do his final training from there," said Small, "(then) go from Monmouth to New York and fly Saturday non-stop to LAX." Cigar won the New Orleans H. in his '95 debut before finishing third to Cigar in the Oaklawn H. and Pimlico Special. "If he runs well and shows he can handle the track, we would consider the (July 2) Hollywood Gold Cup," said Small. "If not, there's the Suburban. Spacing-wise, either race would be fine."

TEN FOR EPSOM OAKS Friday's Vodafone Oaks at Epsom will be a domestic affair, with only the Godolphin-owned **Moonshell** (Sadler's Wells), Newmarket-based but officially trained in Dubai, representing a non-British yard. Ten fillies are expected to run in the \$393,279 Classic. There are: Aqaarid (Nashwan), Asterita (Rainbow Quest), Bint Zamayem (Rainbow Quest), Bunting (Shaadi), Dance A Dream (Sadler's Wells), Kshessinskaya (Kadeer), Last Spin (Unfuwain), Moonshell, Musetta (Cadeaux Genereux), and Pure Grain (Polish Precedent). The latest betting has established Aqaarid at 6-4, with Moonshell 7-4.

"This is a fantastic thrill," said owner Peter Savill. "That was the longest last three furlongs in a race I can remember. Kevin Darley rode him beautifully, always had him in a good position. He looked to be going easily, but then he had to battle to the line. He probably idled when he was in front. I'm not thinking in terms of the Epsom Derby right now--I only want to celebrate!" Trainer Lady Anne Herries was pleased at the colt's staying ability. "I'm very thrilled and very relieved," said Herries. "He seemed to stay the mile and a half well. He certainly stuck on well at the end. Let's hope we can now take on Pennekamp in the Irish Derby." Rider Kevin Darley, who earned his first Classic win here, said he was a little concerned at the slow pace. "I sat handy and moved him closer to the front around the far turn," said Darley. "We went second two furlongs out and then he found a length on the others with a furlong and a half to run. I think he then idled in front, as he often does. The ground definitely helped him. He battled on really well and really stuck his neck out."
