HIGH FIVE FOR LUKAS What are the odds against winning even one Triple Crown race? What are the odds of sweeping one Triple Crown with two different horses? And, as trainer D. Wayne Lukas pointed out after saddling Kentucky Derby winner Thunder Gulch (Gulch) to a two-length victory in yesterday's Belmont S., "What are the odds that a farm boy from Wisconsin, where they don't even have racing, would end up with five straight Classic wins?" But that is the record that Lukas set with his Belmont triumph, taking the final two legs of the '94 Crown with **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat) and splitting the first two of '95 with Thunder Gulch and Timber Country (Woodman). The odds of a record fifth straight Triple Crown win lengthened considerably late Friday afternoon when the early 6-5 favorite Timber Country spiked a fever and had to be withdrawn. But Lukas made history just the same. "The emotion of it surprised me," he said. "It hit me when I was walking through the grandstand after the race--Holy Mackerel, we pulled this off anyhow! It got to me; this means a lot. Statistically, we have carved out a spot in the sport that will be there for a while." The win was the first for jockey Gary Stevens in the third jewel of the Triple Crown. "This weekend at Belmont has to be the best weekend in racing that I ever had," Stevens said. "Winning with Serena's Song (Rahy) yesterday in the Mother Goose, coming back today and winning the Belmont... unbelievable." When asked what's next for his latest dual Classic winner, Lukas replied, "I think we will take Thunder Gulch to the West Coast for the Swaps S., and then maybe the Pacific Classic. Timber Country will be pointed for the Dwyer, depending on his temperature, and then the Haskell and the Travers. Then we'll be back at Belmont with both of them in the fall. We'll run one in the Woodward, one in the Jockey Club Gold Cup and both in the Breeders' Cup Classic."

### TIMBER COUNTRY REBOUNDS Timber Country

(Woodman), scratched from yesterday's Belmont after being treated for a fever Friday, was out grazing on the Belmont backstretch yesterday, his temperature back to normal. "I came out at 10 p.m. (Friday) night and gave him a little grain," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "He started banging around and rattling his feed tub and ate up. I gave him a little more and he cleaned that up, too. His temperature is normal and he's doing great." Lukas said he would keep the Preakness winner in New York for the July 2 Dwyer S.

Soon after the break DAFFAQ (Unfuwain) led the field with MARALINGA (Simply Great {Fr}) in 2nd and the favorite PENNEKAMP (Bering {GB}) near the back. At the top of the hill, Maralinga took the lead from COURT OF HONOR (Ire) (Law Society) and FAHAL (Silver Hawk), with Presenting on the rail. Tamure and Fahal looked to have the race sewn up with with 300 meters to go, when Lammtarra came with an outstanding run to make up six lengths and win easily on his first start this year and only 2nd start of his life. Pennekamp appeared to be running on the wrong lead and finished lame; jockey Thierry Jarnet said he jarred himself crossing a dirt road entering the straight. The win was bittersweet for jockey Walter Swinburn, a close friend of the late Alex Scott, who trained Lammtarra as a 2yo before his tragic murder last October. After the race, Swinburn said, "Alex believed in this horse before he even got going. Everything seemed to be wrong in the first two furlongs, then it just went right. I knew I was going to win with a furlong left to go." There was a brief stewards' inquiry after the race as it appeared at one point that Lammtarra may have hindered Munwar, but the latter was judged to have already been beaten and the result stood. Lammtarra's dam, Snow Bride, was awarded the Oaks after the controversial DQ of the Aga Khan's filly Aliysa five years ago. Lammtarra may now be pointed to the Irish Derby, where he would meet French Derby winner Celtic Swing, Daffag, who was impeded during the running of the race, appeared to have been injured in the incident.
